In each of the three years of the common lectionary (recommended texts over a three year cycle) one of the Gospels is prominent. We are now in Year "A". There are some passages from the Gospel of John, but the prominent Gospel writer is Luke.

I love Luke. I love Luke because Luke is a story teller who includes lots of parables and lots of ways we can enter the life of Jesus to know him better. This month there are two of the best known and most beloved of all the parables—one about a man left to die along a road, and one about two sisters who sometimes just don't see eye to eye.

For me, stories enter our imagination. We have our own pictures of just how the people look and what the landscape is like. We might even know the voices of the characters who are speaking in the words we read. My son loved Harry Potter movies, but he always said he liked the books better—because the movie didn't look like the Harry he saw or the wizard he met in the pages he couldn't stop turning.

The parables do exactly the same thing. Each time we hear one that we have heard before it touches us in a new way—we are caught by a different character. Sometimes I am lying beside the road. Sometimes I am walking by the person lying beside the road. Sometimes I am stuck in the kitchen, sometimes I am sitting down to listen to words that calm me and transform me.

So in the lazy days of summer...My invitation to all of us is -- keep on reading the stories in the Bible! They are the foundation of our faith. They tell us the stories of God's people. More than anything they catch us where we are now and help us know just where to go next as we walk with Jesus along the way.

Not much to report for the month of June other than to share that our 2nd floor CE building railing has been repaired.


Trustees will be off for July and return the 3rd week of August. Have a great summer everyone!

GOOD NEWS FOR ONCE FROM YOUR TREASURER

The Employee Retention Credit (ERC) - sometimes called the Employee Retention Tax Credit or ERTC is a refundable tax credit for certain eligible businesses and tax-exempt organizations that had employees and were affected during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Our church was eligible for this credit and we applied for it.

I am very pleased to announce that our claims were verified and accepted. We received checks from the Internal Revenue Service totaling \$345,461. After paying the CPA for claim preparation (\$10,500) we have deposited \$334,961 into our endowment investment account.
