There is a wonderful passage from the letter to the Philippians that was my Mom's favorite and so, mine too. "Rejoice in the Lord always, again I say rejoice. Let your gentleness be known to everyone. The Lord is near. Do not worry about anything but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God which surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

We give God our hearts when we pray, we give God our worries, our fears. We ask God to forgive us for all we have done which has pulled us away from God, or caused harm or pain to another. We ask God for strength to follow Jesus. We ask God for wisdom to make good decisions. We ask God to protect us from harm, and to protect all those who work to keep us safe and to keep us healthy. We ask God for the courage to live righteously and justly with mercy and kindness.

There is nothing quite like the gratitude I hear in the voice and see in the face of a person who has been lifted to God in the prayers of another. Sometimes it is at church. Sometimes on our band of prayer. Sometimes in an e-blast or at the end of our 10 at 10 devotions. It might be a close friend or a total stranger.

We feel such awe and wonder when someone dares to whisper our name to God, to ask God for healing, or comfort, or direction, or a glimmer of light during a dark time of a soul. And while our faith assures us that God knows us and knows what we need, there is a sacred power when someone speaks our name in their conversation with God—I believe the most intimate conversations we have.

Every time you offer a prayer for someone, whether you know them or not, you are bringing God to them: God's healing, God's comfort, God's strength and God's love.

On behalf of those who share how much it means and what a difference it makes, I thank you so very very much.

A few moths ago Jeri Christensen gave me a pamphlet she had found hidden in a very rare and old book. It briefly lists four questions, the first of which is: What is it to be a Christian? Here's what was printed for that first topic.

"What is it to be a Christian?"

- 1. In a word it is to be like Christ.
- 2. To be a disciple or learner of Christ. —John 8:31; 13:35
- 3. To be a follower of Christ. —Matthew 9:9
- 4. To be a witness for Christ. —Isaiah 43:10; Acts 22:15
- 5. To be a servant of Christ. -1 Corinthians 7:22
- 6. To be a friend of Christ and in fellowship with Him. —John 15:14-15

I truly appreciate writers who back up their thoughts with bible verses, and there's a lot of important ideas here! Personally I was most interested in number 6, about fellowshipping with Jesus. The verses cited come right after Jesus' parable about how He is the vine, we are the branches, and that together we can produce much fruit. That sounds like fellowship to me!

Jesus then says that God's love for Him is the same as Jesus' love for us - amazing! To remain in His love, we must keep His command to "Love each other as I have loved you." So, in the words of The Youngbloods (1967), "Come on people now, smile on your brother. Everybody get together - try to love one another right now."
