February is the month of valentines and presidents....as a child that meant red construction paper hearts and black construction paper silhouettes of President Washington and President Lincoln.

This year February is also the month when Lent begins. Lent is a season of reflection and contemplation during the six weeks before Easter. We will begin the Lenten season with communion on Ash Wednesday which is on February 18. This service is held in the sanctuary from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. We invite you to “Come when you may, leave when you must.” The sacrament is given individually, so you can come forward whenever you are ready. The sanctuary is silent for personal prayer and meditation.

Lent is a holy time as we prepare to journey with Jesus to his last supper with his disciples, and to the cross, anticipating Easter Sunday when Jesus rises from death. It is a time of reflection about Jesus and his life, and our own lives of faith.

I deeply appreciate what Russian born Roman Catholic writer Catherine Doherty wrote about Lent:

“Lent is a time of going very deeply into ourselves... What is it that stands between us and God? Between us and our brothers and sisters? Between us and life, the life of the Spirit? Whatever it is, let us relentlessly tear it out, without a moment”

So may we each bravely contemplate our lives with God, ridding ourselves of all the distractions, all the uncertainties that “stand between us and God.” For these Lenten days are our own journey to the center of our faith, to God’s own son and his great sacrifice for us all.

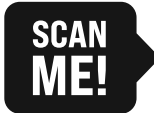

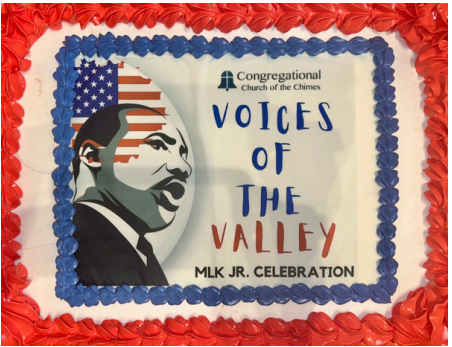
