Every year I have at least one Advent calendar—it started when I was little girl and I have never given it up. Granted, sometimes I forget to open the window, but I eventually catch up. It was always a choice between one with Mary and Joseph and Jesus and the animals in the stable and something Santa. Some years, I got both. For a while I was a rarity among my friends, some not even quite sure what an Advent calendar was. For many years they were hard to find —stuck in a corner at a bookstore, perhaps, or at a store somewhere nestled in the greeting card section.

Then I noticed that things changed. When Teddy was little, my sister sent a wooden one with 25 doors when each day I put something little inside from candy to coins to...toys small enough to fit. Then I found lots of calendars that had candy behind each window. My great find was when visiting New York and finding an Advent calendar at the Metropolitan Museum of Art—gorgeous. It is now my go to place. Suddenly, it seems that Advent calendars are all over. One of the news shows featured the calendars as ways to count the days 'til Santa came. I was surprised, and then...oddly, somewhat saddened.

So many people buying the calendars with candy or jelly or wee bottles of liquor have no idea what Advent really is: the four weeks of quiet anticipation as we await the arrival of the baby Jesus, the son of God, the light of the world. Advent is the season of preparation, getting ready for the birth of our savior. Preparing not by shopping or baking or wrapping but by pausing in our lives to...take a breath, so beautifully described by Frederick Buechner in his book Whistling in the Dark:

"...if you concentrate just for an instant, far off in the deeps of yourself somewhere you can feel the beating of your heart. For all its madness and lostness, not to mention your own, you can hear the world itself holding its breath. So in these coming days, it is hope awaiting us, light to come to us, and love to swaddle us."
