I like October 31 because I like Halloween. I like lots about Halloween. I like candy pumpkins, even though I don't like pumpkin flavored coffee or waffles or even pies. I like costumes. I like seeing what children are thinking they would like to be: super heroes or ghosts or goblins or princesses or unicorns or a Los Angeles Dodger. I like the decorations. I like having skeletons hanging from trees and orange and black everywhere from the filling in Oreos to the banners on those Halloween stores that pop up this time of the year.
