This industry-focused curriculum offers not only 15 to 18-year-olds but also veterans and adult students the opportunity to learn lean manufacturing skills in preparation for a productive future in wood products manufacturing. Graduates are prepared to be part of your skilled workforce.

With 61 global partners providing tools, materials, hardware, software, and technology, the National Training Center at the MiLL is a groundbreaking three-way partnership between public education, industry suppliers and employers, creating a pipeline to channel skilled employees into your business.
