



Quick Start Guide

1. Check engine oil
2. Press vibration switch reset button
3. Turn the choke OFF. (Choke does not help starting when using propane/natural gas)
4. Set the throttle to idle position
5. Turn ON all propane/natural gas valves (gas will not flow until the engine begins turning)
6. Press propane/natural gas primer button on back of large (silver) low-pressure regulator for 1-2 seconds or until the odour of propane/natural gas is detected.
7. Turn key to "start" position for a maximum of 5 seconds.
8. If the engine does not start, repeat steps 6 and 7 until engine starts.

Note: When the engine throttle is increased to full speed, the transient vibrations during acceleration may cause the vibration safety switch to trip. If this occurs allow the engine to stop, turn the key off and press the vibration switch reset button. While increasing the throttle on the next attempt, keep the vibration reset button depressed until the engine reaches full speed, then release the reset button.
