A Doctor Visit

Sometimes I go to the doctor. The doctor helps keep me healthy.

I can use my talker to say:

In the Waiting Room

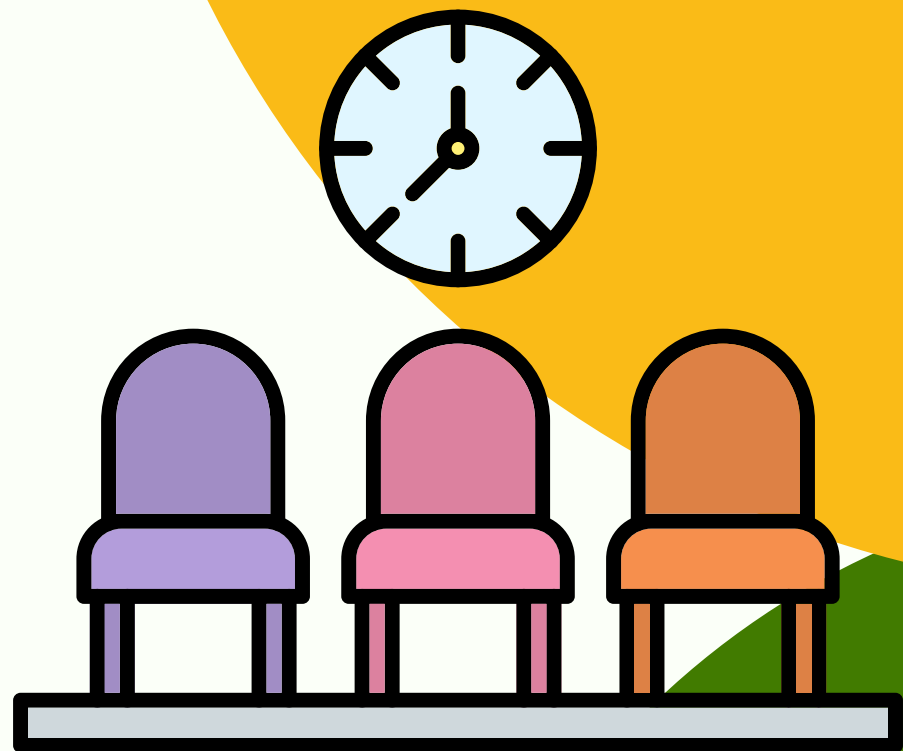
I might wait with my caregiver. There may be other people around.

I can use my talker to say:

"I'm waiting"

or

"All done waiting" when it's time.

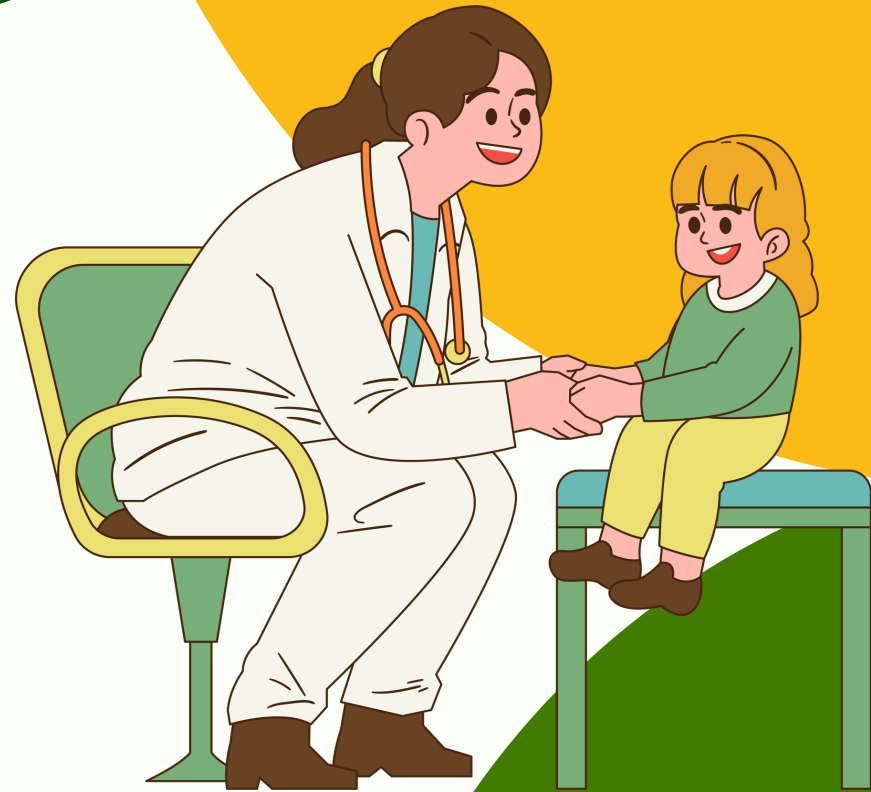


The Exam Room

A nurse or doctor will call my name. We go to another room.

I can use my talker to say:

"That's me!" or "Let's go!"



What Might Happen

The doctor may look in my ears, check my body, or ask questions.

If I'm uncomfortable, I can use my talker to say:

"Stop" or "I don't like that"



All done!

When the doctor visit is over, I leave with my caregiver.

I can use my talker to say:

"All done!" or "Good job, me!"
