

CPC Pavilion Use Guidelines for Small Group Gatherings

PURPOSE

To define hygiene and distancing practices designed to allow small groups to gather safely in the outdoor picnic pavilion at Community Presbyterian Church

GUIDELINES:

- 1) Group size – gatherings are limited to no more than 20 people (at the current time, this is a beginning and will be reviewed as circumstances warrant).
- 2) Seating arrangements – two per picnic table, seated on opposite sides and diagonal from each other
 - a. EXCEPTIONS: Members of the same household may sit together
 - b. Tables should not be moved from their normal positions
- 3) Hygiene
 - a. Hand washing or sanitizer use expected of all members on arrival and departure
 - b. Hand sanitizer to be provided in the pavilion by the group organizer
 - c. If possible, 2 days should be scheduled between events
- 4) Food service
 - a. All food and drinks must be pre-packaged for individual servings or served by a single server
 - b. Groups should avoid common touch points such as condiment containers, stacks of eating utensils, and etc.
 - c. Group organizers are responsible for cleaning the picnic table and serving table surfaces before and after any event
- 5) Mask wear
 - a. Masks must be worn upon arrival, departure, and when mingling
 - b. Masks may be removed when eating
 - c. Mask use is suggested while sitting but masks may be removed if all participants are adequately distanced (>6ft apart)
