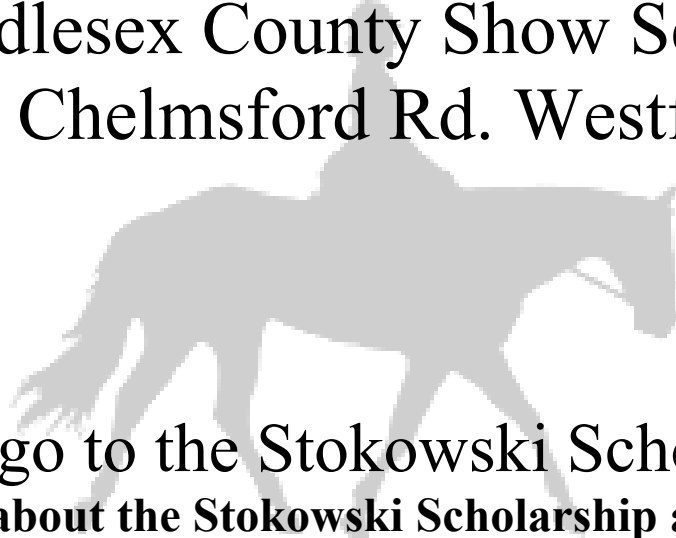

RULES

1. A Lead-line rider is 5 to 7 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.
2. A Walk/Trot rider is 8 to 18 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.
3. A Junior rider is 8 to 13 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.
4. A Senior rider is 14 to 18 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.
5. An Adult rider is 19 and over as of January 1 of the current year.
6. 4-H classes are open only to enrolled 4-H members 8 years old and up. 4-H mounted classes are walk trot canter.
7. All horses that kick must wear a red ribbon in their tail.
8. Safety is our first concern. Unruly horses/people will be asked to leave the show grounds without refund.
9. Show committee reserves the right to dismiss any horses that appear to be lame or sick.
10. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the fairgrounds. No smoking in the vicinity of horses, riders, or trailers. No cooking appliances or grills permitted.
11. ASTM Approved helmets must be worn by **ALL** participants (including Adults) and all riders must wear hard soled shoes with a heel (for in-hand, see Additional Rules below).
12. **Western Division** riders must use an *approved* curb bit, half-breed or spade bit and ride one-handed. Snaffle bits/two handed riding only permitted for horses under 5 years old. **Gymkhana riders** may use an *approved* snaffle, hackamore, or curb bit for any seat and may ride two-handed. Refer to [2026 NE bit guidelines](#) for approved bits.
13. Participants are responsible for their own property. Middlesex County 4-H Fair Inc. & Middlesex Horse Advisory Council shall not be held responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged property.
14. This horse show is being run under the rules of the [New England 4-H Horse Show Rules and Guidelines 2026](#).
15. Refunds are not given unless bona fide injury to horse or rider.
16. Stallions are not permitted at this show.
17. Current negative Coggins required for all equines. Name and description must be the same on all the paperwork.
18. Show committee reserves the right to combine or cancel classes or change class order if needed.
19. All riders who enter the ring without a number will be disqualified from that class.

In-Hand Class Rules (open to horses, ponies, small equine and donkeys/mules)

1. An in-hand exhibitor is 8 and over as of January 1 of the current year.
2. Classes are judged on manners and performance. Neatness/cleanliness of horse, tack, and handler are also considered.
3. Handler should be dressed in a long-sleeved shirt, pants (solid colored jeans or dress pants without holes) but not necessarily dressed in riding attire.
4. A hat must be worn and may be seat specific. ASTM approved riding helmets are not required but are encouraged.
5. Horse and rider combinations may enter both Open Equine in-Hand and mounted divisions.
6. Handlers must wear boots with a distinguishable heel except in ground poles in which sneakers are optional.
