Flying Change 4-H Equestrians Open 4-H Horse Show RULES

- 1. A Lead-line rider is 5 to 7 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.
- 2. A Walk/Trot rider is 8 to 18 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.
- 3. A Junior rider is 8 to 13 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.
- 4. A Senior rider is 14 to 18 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.
- 5. An Adult rider is 19 and over as of January 1 of the current year.
- 6. 4-H classes are open only to enrolled 4-H members 8 years old and up. 4-H mounted classes are walk trot canter.
- 7. All horses that kick must wear a red ribbon in their tail.
- 8. Safety is our first concern. Unruly horses and/or people will be asked to leave the show grounds without refund.
- 9. Show committee reserves the right to dismiss any horses that appear to be lame or sick.
- 10. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the fairgrounds.
- 11. ASTM Approved helmets must be worn by all participants 19 and under as of January 1 of the current year and all riders must wear hard soled shoes with a heel (for in-hand and small equine, see In-Hand Class Rules and Additional Rules below).
- 12. Participants are responsible for their own property. Middlesex Horse Advisory Council shall not be held responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged property.
- 13. This horse show is being run under the rules of the New England 4-H Horse Show Rules and Guidelines.
- 14. Refunds are not given unless bona fide injury to horse or rider.
- 15. Stallions are not permitted at this show.
- 16. Current negative Coggins required for all equine. Name and description must be the same on all paperwork.
- 17. Show committee reserves the right to combine or cancel classes or change class order if needed.

In-Hand Class Rules (Small Equine and Open Horse in-Hand)

1. An in-hand exhibitor is 8 and over as of January 1 of the current year.

2. Classes are judged on manners and performance. Neatness and cleanliness of horse, tack, and handler are also considered.

3. Handler should be dressed in a long-sleeved shirt, pants (non-faded, solid colored jeans or dress pants without holes) but not

necessarily dressed in riding attire.

4. A hat must be worn and may be seat specific. ASTM approved riding helmets are not required but are encouraged.

5. In-Hand exhibitors will enter 4-H Fitting ∧ Showmanship (class 1) if horse/handler is properly enrolled in 4-H, and/or Open

Showmanship (class 2). For day-end championships, class 1 will count if both class 1 and 2 are entered. Additional Rules for Open Horse in-Hand Division

- 1. Horse and rider combinations may enter both Open Horse in-Hand and mounted divisions.
- 2. Open Horse in-Hand handler/horse combinations cannot cross enter with Small Equine Division.

3. Handlers must wear boots with a distinguishable heel.

Additional rules for Small Equine Division

- 1. Small Equine horse must be 48 inches or less when measured at the last mane hairs on the withers.
- 2. Handlers must wear boots with distinguishable heel except in jumping in which sneakers are optional.
- 3. For Small Equine Over Fences, exhibitors may not go over jumps with the horses.
