HAC Open Horse Show RULES

- 1. A Lead-line rider is 5 to 7 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.
- 2. A Walk/Trot rider is 8 to 18 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.
- 3. A Junior rider is 8 to 13 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.
- 4. A Senior rider is 14 to 18 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.
- 5. An Adult rider is 19 and over as of January 1 of the current year.
- 6. 4-H classes are open to enrolled 4-H members 8 years old and up. 4-H mounted classes are walk trot canter.
- 7. All horses that kick must wear a red ribbon in their tail.
- 8. Safety is our first concern. Unruly horses/people will be asked to leave the show grounds without refund.
- 9. Show committee reserves the right to dismiss any horses that appear to be lame or sick.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the fairgrounds. No smoking in the vicinity of horses, riders, or trailers. No cooking appliances or grills permitted.
- 11. ASTM Approved helmets must be worn by all participants 19 and under as of January 1 of the current year and all riders must wear hard soled shoes with a heel (for in-hand division, see Additional Rules below).
- 12. Western division riders must use an *approved* curb bit, half-breed or spade bit and ride one-handed. Snaffle bits/two handed riding only permitted for horses under 5 years old. Gymkhana riders may use an *approved* snaffle, hackamore, or curb bit for any seat and may ride two-handed. Use <u>NE bit guidelines</u> for approved bits.
- 13. Participants are responsible for their own property. Middlesex Horse Advisory Council shall not be held responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged property.
- 14. This horse show is being run under the rules of the New England 4-H Horse Show Rules and Guidelines.
- 15. Refunds are not given unless bona fide injury to horse or rider.
- 16. Stallions are not permitted at this show.
- 17. Current negative Coggins required for all equines. Name and description must be the same on all paperwork.
- 18. Show committee reserves the right to combine or cancel classes or change class order if needed.
- 19. All riders who enter the ring without a number will be disqualified from that class.

In-Hand Class Rules (open to horses, ponies, small equine, donkeys/mules)

- 1. An in-hand exhibitor is 8 and over as of January 1 of the current year.
- 2. Classes are judged on manners and performance. Neatness/cleanliness of horse, tack, handler also considered.
- 3. Handlers should be dressed in a long-sleeved shirt, pants (solid colored jeans or dress pants without holes) but not necessarily dressed in riding attire.
- 4. A hat must be worn and may be seat specific. ASTM approved riding helmets not required but are encouraged.
- 5. In-Hand exhibitors will enter 4-H Fitting & Showmanship (class 1) if horse/handler is enrolled in 4-H, and/or Open Showmanship (class 2). For day-end championships, class 1 will count if both class 1 and 2 are entered.
- 6. Horse and rider combinations may enter both Open Horse in-Hand and mounted divisions.
- 7. Handlers must wear boots with a distinguishable heel except in ground poles in which sneakers are optional.
