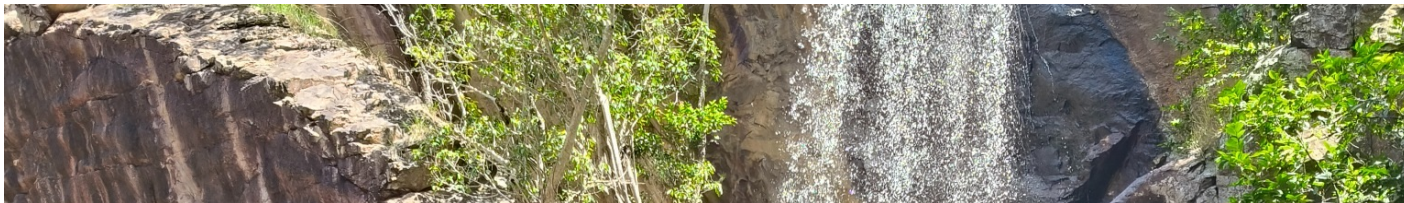

DARWIN TO KAKADU & KATHERINE

Wetlands, rock art, wildlife, waterfalls and Nitmiluk gorge country



DAY 1

DARWIN TO KAKADU

Fogg Dam Wetlands

Begin in the tropical floodplains with birdlife, seasonal wetlands and excellent early photography.

Ubirr Rock Art

Explore ancient Aboriginal galleries and, conditions permitting, climb to the Nadab floodplain lookout.

Burrungkuy / Nourlangie

Rock art, cultural interpretation and sandstone escarpment landscapes.

Kakadu sunset

Finish the day with golden-hour views across Kakadu's escarpment and floodplain country.

OVERNIGHT

Basic Kakadu accommodation included. Hotel / lodge upgrades available.

DAY 2

KAKADU TO KATHERINE

Yellow Water sunrise cruise - included

Wildlife cruise through Kakadu wetlands with crocodiles, buffalo, waterbirds and lily-covered floodplains.

Edith Falls / Leliyn

Travel south for a scenic waterfall and swimming stop when access and conditions permit.

Katherine / Nitmiluk Gorge cruise - included

Late-day gorge experience among towering sandstone walls, reflections and wildlife.

Private overland pace

The exact order can be adjusted for seasonal access, cruise timing and guest comfort.

OVERNIGHT

Basic private motel room in Katherine included. Cicada Lodge upgrade available.

KATHERINE TO TENNANT CREEK & ALICE SPRINGS

Thermal springs, legendary roadhouses and the long Outback road south

DAY 3

KATHERINE TO TENNANT CREEK

Mataranka Thermal Springs

Relax in warm spring-fed water beneath tropical palms when seasonal access permits.

Larrimah Roadhouse

Classic Stuart Highway stop and a glimpse of remote Territory life.

Daly Waters Pub

One of the Northern Territory's best-known Outback pubs and a memorable road-trip stop.

Tennant Creek arrival

Continue across the changing landscapes of the Top End and Barkly region into Tennant Creek.

OVERNIGHT

Basic private motel room in Tennant Creek included.

DAY 4

TENNANT CREEK TO ALICE

Karlu Karlu / Devils Marbles

Walk among the giant granite boulders and learn about this remarkable desert landscape.

Stuart Highway journey

Travel through vast cattle-station country and remote Central Australian scenery.

Barkly and desert horizons

Photography and interpretation stops are chosen along the route according to conditions and timing.

Alice Springs arrival

Reach the Red Centre capital for the first of two nights.

OVERNIGHT

Basic private room in Alice Springs included - first of two nights.

Long-distance touring is part of the experience. Breaks, photography stops and road conditions are built into the day rather than treated as a simple transfer.

WEST MACDONNELL RANGES & KINGS CANYON

Gorges, waterholes, desert geology and remote canyon country

DAY 5

WEST MACDONNELL RANGES

Simpsons Gap

Short walks and dramatic quartzite walls close to Alice Springs.

Standley Chasm

A narrow gorge where light and red rock create one of the West Macs' classic scenes.

Ellery Creek Big Hole

Iconic waterhole and a relaxed scenic stop, with swimming when safe and suitable.

Ormiston Gorge & Mt Sonder

Explore the dramatic western ranges with viewpoints, walks and changing desert colours.

OVERNIGHT

Second basic private room in Alice Springs included.

DAY 6

ALICE TO KINGS CANYON

Alice Springs heritage

Telegraph Station, local history and town interpretation before leaving Alice Springs.

Remote desert route - optional

For suitable small groups and road conditions, a more adventurous Giles Road / remote 4WD route may be selected.

Kings Canyon walks

Kings Canyon Rim Walk or Kings Creek Walk, chosen according to temperature, timing and guest fitness.

Canyon country sunset

Finish surrounded by the sandstone landscapes of Watarrka National Park.

OVERNIGHT

Basic motel/cabin room or air-conditioned permanent tent with proper beds included.

Kings Canyon Rim Walk is demanding and may be restricted in high temperatures. Easier walking alternatives are always available.

THE SACRED DESERT HEART

Uluru sunset, Kata Tjuta sunrise and a memorable final day

DAY 7

KINGS CANYON TO ULURU

Mount Conner lookout

A classic stop over desert country and salt-lake landscapes on the road to Yulara.

Uluru base experience

Mala Walk and selected cultural sites around Uluru, with interpretation of Anangu culture and Tjukurpa.

Uluru sunset

Finish the day watching the rock change colour as the desert light fades.

OVERNIGHT

Basic Yulara / Uluru-area accommodation included. Hotel upgrades available.

DAY 8

KATA TJUTA & DEPARTURE

Kata Tjuta sunrise

Early views of the 36 domes and the surrounding desert landscape.

Walpa Gorge walk

A scenic walk between towering Kata Tjuta domes, adjusted for heat and fitness.

Cultural Centre & final Uluru stops

Complete any remaining cultural experiences before the scheduled airport transfer.

Departure

Transfer to Yulara Airport or, where specifically booked and timed, onward to Alice Springs.
