DAY 1 - WETLANDS & ROCK ART

Fogg Dam Wetlands

Birdwatching paradise and a peaceful introduction to the tropical floodplains.

South Alligator River Ecosystems

Explore wetland environments, seasonal habitats and wildlife country.

Ubirr Rock Art

Ancient galleries, cultural interpretation and stories connected to Country.

Ubirr Lookout

Optional climb for sunset views over the Nadab Floodplain, subject to heat and guest mobility.

Cahills Crossing

East Alligator River tidal crossing and one of Kakadu's best-known crocodile viewing locations.

Optional Arnhem Land Experience

Cultural experience with Indigenous guides when available and conditions permit.

DAY 2 - CULTURE & WILDLIFE

Burrungkuy / Nourlangie Rock Art

Explore Anbangbang galleries and learn about culture, ceremony, contact history and living traditions.

Optional Bush Walks & Hidden Trails

Choose from escarpment, monsoon forest and cultural walks according to season, fitness and heat.

Optional Nawurlandja Lookout

A panoramic viewpoint over Kakadu's stone country and floodplains when conditions are suitable.

Yellow Water Cruise - Included

Cruise the wetlands for saltwater crocodiles, waterbirds, buffalo, lilies and changing reflections.

Secret Corners of Kakadu

Use the flexibility of private touring to add quiet viewpoints, wildlife stops and lesser-known places.

DAY 3 - WATERFALLS & HISTORY

Maguk / Barramundi Gorge

4WD access and a moderate rocky walk to a beautiful waterfall and natural plunge-pool setting. Swimming only when open and safe.

Secret Waterholes & Pristine Nature

Depending on season and access, enjoy quieter Kakadu swimming places and wilderness stops selected for the group.

Pine Creek

Historic gold-rush town and old railway hub offering a glimpse into Top End pioneering history.

Adelaide River War Cemetery

A peaceful final reflection stop connected to the Northern Territory's Second World War history.

Return to Darwin

Private drop-off at your accommodation or another agreed Darwin location at the end of the tour.
