LIGHTING RESTRICTIONS AND LIGHTS OUT POLICY

Lighting Restrictions

For the safety of all participants, certain halogen lights are considered unsafe and will not be allowed on the show floor. This policy has been implemented to minimize the risk of fire associated with halogen lighting. Exhibitors should carefully review their lighting equipment prior to the show to ensure compliance. Please refer to the attached samples of approved and prohibited halogen bulbs for guidance. Any noncompliant lighting must be removed or replaced before installation.

Lights Out Policy

To conserve energy and maintain safety, all exhibitor booth lighting must be turned off at the close of each show day. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that lights, including decorative or display lighting, are powered down each night.

HELPFUL HINT:

Plug all lights into an approved power strip(s), not to exceed 1400 watts per power strip. Remember to place the power strip in a readily accessible area within your booth and turn off the power strip each night at close of show.
