

Luminary Lamp

CLASS DESCRIPTION: The Luminary Lamp class is a creative workshop where you will transform a cannonball gourd into a unique, illuminated light. You will begin by woodburning designs onto the surface of your gourd. After the woodburning is complete, you will paint your designs, make the holes and insert some beads (if desired) that I will furnish. You will have a light base for the lamp that I will furnish. All lamps will be different and may or may not be completed in class because of the creativity, detail, and speed of working.

The instructor will provide: Gourd, Light kit, knob for top of lamp, ideas. (templates will be available to borrow)

Students should leave with a completely sculpted bird. Painting will depend on whether the sculpting medium is dry enough. No two birds will be alike, so just have fun!

The instructor will provide: Gourd for the project, Armature wire for a beak, Craft feathers, but you can bring your own if you prefer, Material for legs and feet, Floral tape & Floral wire, Craft eyes, Wood base, Place mats to work on, Paper towels, Battery powered drill and drill bits, Wire cutter pliers (May not have enough for the entire class so we can share).

Students to bring: Your choice... Quickwood, Apoxie Sculpt or Paper Clay. I prefer Apoxie Sculpt or Paper Clay due to its longer working time, Basic clay sculpting tools, Super glue, Paint (4 or 5 of your choice), Brushes, your choice (but flat for sure), Pencil, Wet wipes, Apron


