General Rules and Regulations

- OE (or proof of insurance) is required for each rider
- All horses must have a vaccination certificate emailed to us prior to attending their first show (EHV 1 & EHV 4 & EIV vaccination within 6 months but not within 7 days of the horse show along with negative 2026 coggins). hollyhillfarm@live.ca
- Entries close the Wednesday before each show. There is limited parking so there will be a cap on entries as well. First come, first serve.
- If accepted, any late entries will be charged \$25 late fee (after 11:59pm on the Wednesday prior to the show)
- Rider age is as of January 1st, 2026
- Please do bring your dogs to the show
- Adults are permitted to ride ponies
- Approved Head Gear is mandatory. All riders must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted in competition or on event grounds. Approved head gear must meet the ASTM standards.
- Only Holly Hill Riders and their families and staff are permitted to enter the barn.
- Please respect the facilities and use garbage cans provided
- No smoking anywhere on the property
- Grass Reins are allowed in Just off the Lead Line and Beginner Show Rider
- **The divisions Beginner Show Rider and Cross Rails may have the “California Split” applied to them. This would allow the trainer to use the same horse or pony for two riders in the same division. They would be grouped in section A and B.**
- All riders must have a waiver signed before mounting their horse/pony.

GDS Divisions with Descriptions

- **Just off Lead Line:** Open to beginner (junior only) riders or riders not yet confident enough to be in the show ring unaccompanied. Handler to accompany but not lead horse/pony at all times (may lead at trot). 2 classes: Walk/Trot Pleasure Equitation U/S, Walk/Trot Equitation Flat.
- **Beginner Show Rider (Poles):** Walk and Trot only. Consists of 2 rounds over poles equitation and 1 flat equitation class. Course of 4-6 poles. Open to juniors & adult amateurs only.
- **Cross Rails Equitation:** Consists of 2 rounds over cross rails and 1 flat equitation class. Course of 6-8 cross rails. Open to juniors & adult amateurs only. Simple lead changes are permitted.
- **2'/2'3 Open Hunter:** This Division consists of two Over fences classes at your chosen height and one Hunter Under Saddle Class.
- **Hack/Eq Flat Division:** This division consists of a Pleasure Hack, Show Hack and an Equitation on the Flat.

Year-End Awards

- To qualify for year-end awards, riders must participate in 2 out of 4 shows in the same Division.
- Riders collect points not horses (except in the Open Hunter and Hack/Eq Flat Division)
- Year-end awards will be presented to the Champion, Reserve Champion, 3rd, 4th, 5th & 6th place in each division.
