

A. Call to Order.

The meeting was called to order by Ms. Anne Goodnight, CRA Chair at 9:00 A.M.

B. Pledge of Allegiance and Moment of Silence.

Ms. Anne Goodnight led the pledge of allegiance and asked for moment of silence for Mr. Ski Olesky who was going through surgery and for Mr. Don Crabtree who had just passed away.

C. Roll Call and Announcement of a Quorum.

1. Public Comments speaker slips

CRA Staff reiterated the public 3-minute speaker slip policy. The board will give more time if they feel it necessary.

2. Communications Folder

Staff reviewed the communications folder with the board and members of the public. The folder contained the public notice for this meeting and community event flyers for upcoming events. The golf tournament for the Immokalee chamber of commerce will be in Ave Maria at the Panther Run Golf Course and the tickets will be \$100 each. There is a youth speech competition happening in April and the winner will be winning prize money. Parks and recreation will be hosting their Cinco de Mayo event on May 7. There will be a free eye screening on May 22 held at the iTech.

3. Community Meetings (Enclosure 6)

Staff announced public meetings involving the community.

Ms. Andrea Halman asked if there were any virtual capabilities for the water board's meetings. Ms. Goodnight is also on the water board said she would mention it to the Immokalee Water & Sewer District staff.

4. Earth Day on April 22, 2022

Staff announced the Earth Day Event will be held on April 22, 2022. There will be a trash pick-up from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. and other activities at Pepper Ranch Preserve from 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

5. CRA Annual Workshop on May 3, 2022, at BCC Chambers

The CRA workshop will be held May 3rd, staff asks that CRA board members please respond to have a count on who will attend. Staff reminded board and all in attendance that this is the one time of the year that the Immokalee CRA and Bayshore CRA boards gather and discuss with the Governing CRA (BCC) board. Staff announced that there will be no zoom capabilities for the workshop.

2. Other Community Agencies

Collier County Public Schools (CCPC)

Ms. Diana McGowen, the community liaison from the Collier County Public Schools, updated on their behalf: She announced that the Immokalee High School has a new building that allows up to 500 more seats. CCPS predicts capacity being up to 2200-2300 students next year. They are getting rid of portables and all will be in buildings.

Ms. McGowen also updated there are 55 teacher vacancies in Immokalee and that May 2nd through the 5th is teacher appreciation week, CCPS is trying to show their appreciation.

Dr. Nappo pointed out that during covid, there were fewer employees, but the number of students did not go down.

Mr. Jonathan Argueta asked, "What is the school board's impression on the number of migrant students?"

Ms. McGowen suggested bringing expert staff to a future CRA meeting to provide data updates and to elaborate on future plans for Immokalee schools.

Dr. Nappo expressed his concern for how many children are per unit.

Mr. Argueta expressed his concern for the increase of supplement for teachers who travel here.

Ms. McGowen explained that Immokalee needs consistent, high-quality teachers and the district is working hard to get experienced teachers here, Students need strong teachers.

Ms. Andrea Halman asked, "Would affordable housing make a difference in whether or not teachers would be more compelled to work in Immokalee?"

Ms. Halman asked "If teachers are still buying their own supplies for their classrooms?"

After much discussion Ms. McGowen said she would have CCPC staff experts attending a future meeting to answer questions and provide updates on the plans for Immokalee schools.

I. Old Business.

- 1. Immokalee Area Master Plan updates
 - IAMP Policies- LDC Amendments
 Staff will check with county staff on status of the Land Development Code Amendments.



2. Redevelopment Plan updates (Enclosure 7)

Staff announced the Redevelopment Plan is scheduled to go to the Board of County Commission (BCC) on May 10 for adoption. There will be two hearings. On the BCC agenda, under Redevelopment Agencies, it will have presentation for the Redevelopment Plan updates. Enclosure 7 highlights some of the Redevelopment Plan updates. The CCPC has approved, and the final process will be on May 10, 2022. The BCC sitting as the CRA board will vote to pass a resolution. If passed, it will go on to the public hearing for the Board of County Commissioners to then adopt the plan officially. There is no time certain.

3. Catholic Charities update

Staff announced items involving Catholic Charities will also be presented on May 10. The BCC will be sitting as the CRA and will vote for staff to get an appraisal and negotiate. The Catholic Charities item will be on the regular agenda of the BCC, there is no time certain. Commissioner McDaniel mentioned the meeting will be hybrid so folks can sign up and attend virtually.

4. TIGER Grant updates

Staff explained the first meeting with contractor and planning staff has occurred and the CEI (Construction Engineer Inspection) firm has been hired. The first public meeting is scheduled to be held on May 25, 2022, so that people can understand and comment on the Tiger Grant.

At the February 8, 2022, Board of County Commissioners Meeting RFP #20-7811, "Immokalee Area Improvements" TIGER Grant was awarded to Quality Enterprises USA, Inc., for a total not to exceed amount of \$22,869,280.

At the April 12, 2022, Board of County Commissioner Meeting Request for Professional Services ("RPS") No. 21-7877, "Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) Services for TIGER Grant," to Kisinger Campo & Associates Corp., for a total not to exceed amount of \$1,946,572.96, for Project 33563.

The design/build portion of this project is set to start early 2022 and construction is set to be completed early 2024.

Mr. Estil Null asked if the project has started and staff confirmed surveying has begun.

Ms. Andrea Halman asked if anyone does not want the sidewalks and Mr. Null replied that there are people who are not in favor.

Commissioner McDaniel replied he would like for there to be an opt in and opt out process to be developed so that they are consistent. If the whole street does not want the sidewalk, then they will not get the sidewalk. Commissioner McDaniel also said he wanted a system to be development for public concerns.



Ms. Halman asked who makes the decision whether or not the sidewalk gets built and Ms. Anne Goodnight responded the county makes the decision.

J. New Business.

1. CRA 2022 Priorities (Enclosure 8)

Staff explained that with the new Redevelopment Plan being approved, the priorities are being updated. Staff provided board and public with Enclosure 8 which is a recap of all relevant projects for the CRA and the MSTU.

Staff provided a recap on completed project and the upcoming priority projects.

LDC recap: Collier County initiated LCD in Immokalee, according to priority. Commissioner McDaniel wants the Immokalee LDC to be a priority.

Sidewalk Phase III: Staff received 90% plans for Phase III of the South side portion of Immokalee Sidewalk project located on a portion of Delaware from South 5th to First Street and from Eustis to First Street. The MSTU paid for the design portion of the area and funds were just awarded for the construction.

Main Street Streetscape: A direct select was issued to Johnson Engineering and staff is working with them to get a proposal. FDOT finished their project last year on Main Street from 1st Street to 9th Street and now we have extended it to 2nd Street and past Hancock. This area is the MSTU's main focus, but some CRA money will be used for some of the construction. It will take both funds for this project, estimated at 2 million dollars.

First Street Corridor: Staff applied and were awarded CDBG \$250,000 grant for the design portion of this corridor. The funds will be available in October 2023.

Lake Trafford: A direct select was issued to Jacob's Engineering and staff is working to get a proposal for a lighting study to be done to the Lake Trafford area, all the way to the lake. The study will go all the way to the lake, State Road 29, and a portion of Carson.

Parks & Recreation: Another community goal is the Zocalo Park and park partnerships. A concept for Dreamland Neighborhood Park happened April 19, bringing it over to the school (Pinecrest). Staff is meeting bi-weekly with Parks & Rec.

Staff commented 311 works great for things in the community that need to be fixed. 311 is for the county in general, there is an app (Collier 311) where you can take a picture, upload address or you can call.

Ms. Lupita Vázquez Reyes asked for the possibility of an infographic to be done after each monthly CRA Advisory/ MSTU Board meetings to inform for people to be involved.

1. Immokalee Area Master Plan (IAMP) Restudy

(PL201880002258) Approved by BCC for final adoption on 12/10/2019.

Copy of IAMP as amended by Ordinance 2019-47 can be found at www.ImmokaleeCRA.com website.

- Implementation schedule was provided at the November 2020 Meeting.
- County staff discussed IAMP Policy 6.1.3 Downtown Ped Amenities and 3.1.4 Central Business District at the March 17, 2021, CRA Meeting.
- First LDC Workshop was held on May 19, 2021, following the CRA meeting.
- County staff if finalizing Scope of Work for consultant.

2. CRA Office

CareerSource SWFL building is open with mask requirements.

Job Bank Assistant – staff is continuing to use KeyStaff temp service until further action is taken.

3. Redevelopment Plan

Staff issued Notice to Proceed to Johnson Engineering on December 1, 2020, to provide planning support services for the Immokalee Community Redevelopment Plan. This effort is specific to Section 4 of the Collier County Community Redevelopment Agency Community Redevelopment Plan, amended May 2019. The Immokalee Community Redevelopment Plan will be prepared consistent with the policies of the Immokalee Area Master Plan adopted as part of the County's Growth Management Plan on December 10, 2019. Change Order #2 was approved for additional funding and more days. Completion of this project is now set for May 31, 2022 (546 days).

From February 16, 2021, through August 2021, staff conducted online survey with a variety of questions to solicit public input on the following topics: Cultural Survey, Recreation Survey, Housing Survey, Economic Development Survey, and Transportation Survey. All surveys were available in English, Spanish, and Creole. A Community Kick-off Hybrid Meeting was held on March 31, 2021. Focus Group meeting were held the month of April and May. Smaller Focus Group Meetings were held with Guadalupe Staff, RCMA parents, RCMA staff, Chamber Board Members, Coalition of Immokalee Farm Workers (Spanish), Church of the Nazarene (Creole), and the Rotary Club.

On October 20, 2021, staff provided CRA & MSTU board a copy of the Section 4 language and the Immokalee Sidewalk Master Plan for review. Staff requested the board and public to review and provide comments prior to next meeting.

At the November 17, 2021, Joint CRA & MSTU Meeting staff announced that final public comments were submitted, and a presentation would be held on December 14, 2021.

Staff presented at the CRA Advisory Board meeting at 9:00 a.m. on December 14, 2021, and at the Community Input Meeting at 6:00 p.m. at the CareerSource on the same day. Presentation highlighted the goals, objectives, and strategies. Goals included Celebrating Culture, Economic Development, Housing, Infrastructure, and Plan Implementation/Admin.

Staff presented a draft Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan on February 16, 2022. CRA board approved the plan with two additions.

Collier County Planning Commission approved the proposed plan amendment on April 7, 2022.

On May 10, 2022, the of Collier County Board of County Commissioner (BCC), acting as the Community Redevelopment Agency Board (CRA), approved a Resolution recommending approval to the BCC an amendment to the Collier County Community Redevelopment Area Plan.

4. Infrastructure Projects (County) in Immokalee (Not funded by CRA/MSTU)

1) Carson Road Project-Eden Park Elementary Safe Routes to School

- 6' Sidewalk on the south and west side of the road.
- Construction costs \$663,000.
- Funded with Safe Routes to School funds in FY 21/22.
- Construction in FY 22/23
- Adding time to the contract Stop work issued until CO is approved.



2) Lake Trafford Road



Design of bicycle and pedestrian features on Lake Trafford Road from Little League Road to Laurel Street. The project length is approximately 1.850 miles. Specifically, the design will provide for bicycle lanes on each side of the roadway within the project limits and design of a 6' sidewalk on the south side of the roadway from Carson Road to Krystal Lane and from North 18th Street to Laurel Street. Includes adjustment or relocation of the existing signalization at the intersection of Carson Road and 19th Street, if required. Constrained right-of-way at 19th Street intersection may require bike lane tapers to sidewalks and minor incidental intersection improvement at this location. Project 3 is discussed under Stormwater projects. No update

3) Stormwater Improvements

The original Immokalee Stormwater Master Plan (ISWMP) was prepared by H.W. Lochner (2005). Camp Dresser & McKee (CDM) was contracted in 2010 to prepare construction plans for the Downtown Immokalee and Immokalee Drive projects plus update the ISWMP. A draft update document was prepared but not finalized. On November 28, 2018, county staff presented the follow-up analysis.


Immokalee Stormwater Project updates: North 3^{rd.} Street Stormwater Improvements:

The North 3^{rd.} Street Drainage proposed project is located on North 3^{rd.} Street between 2nd Avenue and Roberts Avenue West. The project would include roadside swales, installation of inlets on 3^{rd.} Street, construction of a storm drainpipe system to alleviate ponding and allow conveyance southward to the storm drain system on West Main Street. Cost for repairs is estimated at \$600,000. The grant funding contract is now finalized, and the project is entering the contractor bidding phase. The project manager is Brittany Lazo with Collier County Stormwater Management. No update.

Madison Avenue Channel project:

On the northeastern side of Immokalee, county staff obtained Board of County Commissioners approval to purchase a 6-acre parcel just to the east of the Immokalee Foundation Career Path Learning Lab site. That site will provide a pond site to improve stormwater quality from the outfalls along Madison Ave. Additionally, county staff is working with FDOT's design firms to coordinate the alignment of the SR-29 bypass loop so they can avoid having to route the stormwater from the Madison Avenue channel all the way around the north and east sides of the airport.







Eden Gardens project:

The Eden Garden **Bypass** Drainage Improvement proposed project is located is the area south of Westclox St., east of Boxwood Dr., west of Carson Rd., and generally north and northeast of Eden Gardens. The project would construct a new ditch along the northern boundary of Eden Gardens, install a 24" pipe under Boxwood Dr. to tie into the existing ditch along the northwest boundary of Eden Gardens to convey flows further west. Cost for repairs is estimated at \$602,786.32. The county applied for CDBG-DR grant funding for this project.

Lake Trafford Road Area:

The single negotiated contract for designing both a stormwater treatment facility in the SE corner (Tract 3) of Arrowhead Reserve and drainage improvements along Lake Trafford Road from Little League Road to Tippins Terrace was applied for by the Board of County Commissioners in 2021. County staff is looking at phasing the construction, with Phase 1 being the Arrowhead Tract 3 site and Phase 2 being the pathway and drainage west of Little League Road. Design for Phase 1 was completed in 2021 and construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in the last quarter of 2022. Phase 2 design is anticipated to begin in 2022.



5. Commercial Façade Grant Program

In accordance with objective 1.2 in the Immokalee Area Master Plan, the CRA continues to provide financial incentives to business in Immokalee via the Commercial Facade Improvement grant program. The CRA implanted the Program in October 2008.

Since that time, 17 façade grants have been awarded to local businesses for a total of \$294,621.67.

Eligible applicants may receive grant funding up to \$20,000 as reimbursement, using a one-half (1/2) to 1 match with equal applicant funding for funding for façade improvements to commercial structures.

Program is in place and being reviewed for revisions.



6. FHERO

Florida Heartland Economic Region of Opportunity – updates Staff continues to attend monthly meetings.

The CRA was awarded through FHERO a Site Improvement Plan DEO Grant totally 13,540 for Professional Services for Airpark Blvd. The Proposed scope of work include general consulting, engineering, planning, and survey services to evaluate the subject site for commercial development.



The CRA was also awarded through FHERO a Retail Demand Analysis DEPO Grant totally \$7,700 for Professional Services for assessment of retail demand in the Immokalee Community. Retail Demand Analysis has been finalized.

On June 28, 2021, Governor DeSantis issued Executive Order Number 21-149 which re-designated the South-Central RAO for another five-year term with an expiration date of June 28, 2026.

Staff attend monthly FHERO board meetings via Zoom or in person . The last meeting was held in person on March 14, 2022, in Sebring.

7. Immokalee Unmet Needs Coalition

The Immokalee Unmet Needs Coalition (IUNC) is a long-term recovery group that formed in the fall of 2017 as the result of Hurricane Irma. This group is composed of non-profits, faith based, local, state, or national organizations who work together to meet the unmet of Immokalee residents impacted by disaster. They plan to have an annual meeting in June 2022.



The Housing Committee is updating the Immokalee Disaster Recover Resiliency Plan and funding options for future projects on a quarterly basis.

The Housing committee meetings are held the second Friday of every month via zoom at 10:00 a.m. The next meeting is scheduled for June 10, 2022 @ 10:00 a.m. via Zoom. For information on housing assistance please visit website at: https://www.colliercountyhousing.com/community-assistance-program/

8. Development in Immokalee

1) Guadalupe Center van Otterloo Campus for Learning - 3655 Westclox Street

The Guadalupe Center broke ground on October 30th for a new educational campus that will create lasting, transformational change for students in Immokalee. The van Otterloo Family Campus for Learning will feature two academic buildings with multiple classrooms, a library, learning lab, cafeteria and kitchen, playground, administrative offices, mentor lounges, commons areas, a medical and dental suite, outdoor gardens, and a student wall of fame.

The campus will accommodate up to 154 students in Guadalupe Center's Early Childhood Education Program, as well as 125 high school students in the college-preparatory Tutor Corps Program. Guadalupe Center named the campus in honor of Rose-Marie and Eijk van Otterloo, whose generous \$5 million matching gift helped launch the project and inspired others to give. Within the campus, Brynne & Bob Coletti Hall will become the new home for the Tutor Corps Program. Barron Collier Companies donated 9.5 acres for the new campus. For more information, please visit www.guadalupecenter.org. Grand Opening ceremony for the campus was held April 21, 2022, at 11:00 a.m.





2) Immokalee Foundation Learning Lab 18-home subdivision

The Immokalee Foundation Learning Lab 18-home subdivision is currently under construction. Collier Enterprises donated the 8.3 acres of land for a housing subdivision that will serve as a hands-on learning laboratory for student in the foundation's program., Career Pathways: Empowering Students to Succeed. BCB Homes, is serving as the general contractor.

On July 13, 2021, BCC board meeting (Agenda item 16.F.10) board approved a recommendation to direct staff to develop a workforce development grant agreement with The Immokalee Foundation, to offset development costs on the housing subdivision for the Career Pathways Learning Lab, in the amount of \$500,000.



The Immokalee Foundation sold its first home in December 2021. They also had a celebration for the Career Pathways program and the subdivision on Friday, January 14th from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.



3) Immokalee Fair Housing Alliance (IFHA)

The Immokalee Fair Housing Alliance proposed housing development consist of 8 buildings with 16 apartments each or 128 Units in all. Construction will progress in phases. Housing units will be two- and three-bedroom apartments ranging in size from about 750 to 950 square feet. For more information, please visit http://www.ifha.info/. Revised rendering will be provided at a future meeting. IFHA received final county approval of Site Development Plan (SDP) and they are currently out for bid. Land clearing started in September 2021. Groundbreaking was held on November 10, 2021 @ 10:00 a.m. Construction is under way. The infrastructure is scheduled to be complete in June. IFHA had subcontractor delays. IFHA is continuing to fundraise for the construction of the buildings which is set to start in July.



4) Habitat for Humanity of Collier County Kaicasa Housing Development

Kaicasa will be located at the Southeast corner of Immokalee, on state road 29 as you enter the agricultural village from the south. The new affordable community will sit adjacent to the existing Farm Workers Village: subsidized housing built in the 1970s for local and migrant farm workers that is often criticized for its conditions. Many Habitat Collier partner families have lived there prior to purchasing their homes. Once complete, this neighborhood will boast nearly 280 homes, making it the largest Habitat subdivision in the country. Construction is set to start in August 2022 due to a concrete shortage. Habitat is taking in applications. First phase may be reduced to 65 homes because of the supply shortage.





5) Redlands Christian Migrant Association (RCMA) Childcare Development Center and Community Hub

The RCMA proposed childcare center and community hub consist of Childcare classrooms, Area office, and playground. The development will accommodate 234 children and 30 employees. Approximately 8 acres will be designation for housing. Q. Grady Minor presented updated plan for the RCMA Immokalee MPUD (PL20200001827) at the CRA June 16, 2021, Board Meeting. CRA Board supported the proposed development. At the February 16, 2022, H&F Architects provided updated renderings of the proposed development.






6) Casa San Juan Diego Multi-Family Affordable Housing Development National Development of America, Inc.

The proposed Casa San Juan Diego Multi-Family affordable housing development in Immokalee is a partnership between the National Development of America, Inc., and the Diocese of Venice to develop 80 affordable rental units on 9.6 acres of land adjacent to Our Lady of Guadalupe Church. National Development of America, Inc. applied for grant funding but didn't receive. They will continue to look for other funding to build Casa San Juan Diego development in Immokalee.

7) Casa Amigos – Farmworker units at Esperanza Place

A 96-bed, 24-unit rental community at Esperanza Place. The shared-housing model enables unrelated adults to share rental apartments through individual rather than household leases. Residents enjoy landlord-paid utilities, basic furnishings and service-enriched living at a monthly cost ranging from \$225 to \$250 per month per person. This is Rural Neighborhood's 4th shared housing venture. Completion date is scheduled for October 2022. The small community center is set to start construction in July.





8) Century Communities

Century Communities is offering new homes for sale in Immokalee at Arrowhead Reserve. They are one of the largest new home builders in Immokalee.











9) Proposed 7 *Eleven* at corner of 9th and Main Street





The original proposed development was approved by the CCPC on May 6, 2021. PUD was approved under Zoning Ordinance 21-22 and Resolution 21-116 for 4,650 SF store, 1,000 sf car wash and 16 unleaded and 4 diesel fueling positions. 7 Eleven is requesting to amend PUD to add a drive through and remove car wash.

At the October 20th CRA meeting the advisory board voted unanimously to support requested changes to remove car wash and add drive thru. The proposed development went to the CCPC on February 17, 2022 and was approved with some contingencies. No outdoor music, no Alcohol can be sold from drive thru, and some changes were made to the SIC code. The development was approved by the BCC board on March 22, 2022. Creighton Construction help a pre-construction meeting in March and started clearing property in April.

11) Seminole Trading Post

The Immokalee Trading Post will feature 10 gas pumps, five electric vehicle (EV) charging stations and a 7,200-square-foot convenience store. The dispensers will offer regular, mid-grade, premium, diesel and Rec90 fuel. The plans include two canopies: one in the front for regular vehicles and small trucks, and one in the back for semi-trucks and recreational vehicles. The trading post will work with the nearby Seminole Casino Hotel and accept players' points for gas and items inside the store.

12) Seminole Tribe medical and public safety facility

On April 26, 2022, a groundbreaking ceremony was held for a medical and public safety building on the Immokalee Reservation. The ceremony featured current and past tribal leaders as well as one of the founding mothers of the Immokalee reservation, Nancy Motlow.

13) Immokalee Fire Control District

Groundbreaking was held on September 27, 2021, for Fire Station 30 located at 510 New Market Road. The state-of-the-art firehouse will feature three apparatus bays and be equipped with bunker gear storage and a shop area. The building also will feature a lobby, conference room and two offices. Fire Station No. 30 will replace the existing firehouse located at 502 New Market Road. Construction started in December 2021 and is expected to be completed in December 2022.



14) Budget Inn (PL20220001199 CU)

On March 16, 2022, a pre-application meeting was held with county for a proposed conditional use for the Budget Inn located at 504 E Main Street. Owners are proposing to demolish the existing hotel and potentially do a two or 3 story hotel. They are in the early preliminary stages and don't have a conceptual plan yet.



15) Pathways Early Education Center of Immokalee

Pathways held a pep rally on April 5, 2022, to remove the existing building at 410 Colorado Avenue. Fundraising is underway to construction an additional facility.



9. The Face of Immokalee

On December 12, 2018, Michelle Tricca, a local Artist, presented The Face of Immokalee, a proposed outdoor photography installation celebrating the soul of Immokalee. CRA board supported the project and have formed a subcommittee to move the project forward.

The subcommittee last met on December 9, 2019, to discuss the art wall options for the old McCrory's building (S&O Grocery), Lipman Produce (trucks/building), site on 1st Street (Gadsden blue building), and the Zocalo plaza. Committee supported rendering provided by artist with minor changes.

On October 22, 2020, CRA staff and Lipman staff met with Michelle Tricca to discuss project status. On October 29, 2020, WGCU did a story on Ms. Tricca's public art installation for the Phase 1 portion of the project. Please see link to the WGCU Face of Immokalee Story. On November 18, 2020, both the CRA and MSTU board supported The Face of Immokalee project and made a motion to allow the use of Zocalo Plaza Art Wall as a canvas for the project.

In May 2021 Ms. Tricca provided project updates to staff and announced that the project has started to receive donations via her fiscal sponsorship with ASMP Foundation. She also noted that the project was featured in Florida Weekly.

12. Collier County Opportunity Zone Program

This program is a community and economic development tool to drive long-term private investment in low-income communities! Collier County hopes to leverage Opportunity Zones as an important tool to support the development of jobs, affordable housing, and economic vitality in five areas in Golden Gate, Naples Manor and in and around Immokalee.

Low Tax Opportunity Zones, established by the federal Tax Cut and Jobs Act of 2017, encourage long-term investment and job creation in targeted communities by reducing taxes for many job creators. They enhance the ability to attract businesses, developers, and financial institutions to invest in these targeted areas — distressed communities — by allowing investors to defer capital gains taxes through investments Low Tax Opportunity Zones, established by the federal Tax Cut and Jobs Act of 2017, encourage long-term investment and job creation in targeted communities by reducing taxes for many job creators. The zones enhance local communities' ability to attract businesses, developers, and financial institutions to invest in targeted areas by allowing investors to defer capital gains taxes through investments in federally established Opportunity Funds.

It's an economic and community development tax incentive program that provides a new impetus for private investors to support distressed communities through private equity investments in businesses and real estate ventures. The incentive is deferral, reduction, and potential elimination of certain federal capital gains taxes. To become a Qualified Opportunity Fund, an eligible corporation or partnership self-certifies by filing Form 8996, Qualified Opportunity Fund, with its federal income tax return.

Project Manager Report 05/18/2022

1. Carver Street and S. 5th Street (funded with CDBG and CRA funds) Project #33588.1 Immokalee Sidewalk Project Phase II

Coastal Concrete Products LLC d/b/a Coastal Site Development completed the project. On S 5th Street there was a curb installed along the side of the sidewalk as directed by the County Inspector during the Final Walk Through in April 2021. Warranty Inspection was conducted on 3.17.22 and the Warranty Items have been completed with the exception of the installation of a handrail on the curb which is an unwarranted item. The Contractor is providing Staff with a quote for the handrail on S 5th Street with the installation of a new footer. The existing curb is not substantial enough to support a handrail.

As a proposed post-project improvement, Staff has coordinated with Road Maintenance the paving of Carver Street in the 2022 Maintenance Overlay Schedule.

2. Trash Cans and Garbage Pickup

Staff is continuing cleanup efforts for weekends on Main Street utilizing the Weekend Warriors while our Maintenance Contractor picks up trash during the week. A&M is temporarily making additional trash pick-up and removing trash from bins. Additional services may only be utilized until end of May or early June when the population decreases, and trash decreases in the Summer.

The Immokalee CRA, Collier County Parks & Recreation, The Immokalee Foundation, Immokalee High School, Immokalee Library, and the Botanical Gardens participated in the Earth Day Event held on April 22 from 9-11 AM. Trash was picked up along Main Street from $1^{\rm st}-9^{\rm th}$ Street and on Roberts Avenue. The Botanical Gardens planted at the Immokalee Library and the Immokalee Community Park.

<u>Grates</u>: On 4.7.22 FDOT advised their Engineer provided two solutions to the grate breakage: #1 remove the non-rectangular or shorten grate and segments at the return or #2 welding the two end grates together (which was done and did not work).

Ferrovail Services, FDOT's subcontractor, repaired the three damaged grates with welded in support legs at the end grates within the radius on N 3rd St, S 2nd St and S 4th St grates. They are monitoring how well they hold up. No damage has been noted as of the 5.9.22 MSTU Walking Tour.



<u>Banners</u>: Allegra Naples, Inc. provided the lowest bid of \$2,935 and on 5.9.22 they were authorized to produce one banner to inspect before the production of the remaining 29 banners for Main Street.

4. First Street Zocalo Plaza (107 N. 1st Street)

i. Parks & Recreation Monthly Maintenance

Park staff continue doing monthly maintenance (painting, trimming, cleaning, and mulch) of plaza; and Staff is billing CRA & MSTU quarterly. Staff is monitoring the quality of maintenance services being provided.

ii. CRA

<u>Palmettos</u>. The palmettos on the east side of the stage are overgrown and needed to be trimmed back to help reduce the occupation by the homeless and chickens. The work was completed on 5.9.22 by Facilities Management.







<u>Bird of Paradise</u>. A claim was submitted for the damaged bird of paradise logo sign. Lykins Signtek provided a proof and a \$660 quote for the repairs. Repair work is being scheduled.

<u>Fencing</u>. On 4.1.22 Request for Quotes were sent to vendors to fence in the electrical panel boxed area. Quotes were due 4.22.22 and a 2nd Request was resubmitted with s due date of 5.10.22. No responses and Staff seeking instruction from Procurement on how to proceed.

<u>Lighting</u>. Three (3) Scopes for Work were sent to Simmonds Electrical on 3.30.22 for Quotes. An emergency Purchase Order was issued to Simmonds on 5.6.22 to trouble shoot no power to all lights and the park is dark. On 5.10.22 Simmonds reported contactor is not engaging all the way and needs replaced. As a temporary repair, only lights working, bypassed the receptacles to not overload system until a new contactor is installed. Awaiting quote for repairs.

Scopes of Work:

- 1. Need to get all lights operational on the band shell, trellis, and string of lights over the diagonal walk.
- 2. An analysis on the replacement of light fixtures versus the replacement of bulbs on the existing fixtures located on band shell, the trellis and overhead string of lights.
- 3. Installation of two lights for the exterior rear of the band shell as recommended by the Landscape Architect when Zocalo was built, but never installed.

<u>Memorial Benches</u>. Two 6' memorial benches delivered to the CRA on 5.5.22. A Request for Quotes for the installation of the benches under the trellis was posted on 5.2.22 with a due date of 5.16.22.

Power Wash. The stage was power washed on 5.6.22.

<u>Container</u>. Staff temporarily put on-hold the raising of the storage container 6" and adding a vent until Parks & Recreation moves the existing fence at South Park to accommodate Parks & Recreation's utilization of their field.

5. SR 82 Road Widening Project Gator Slough Lane to SR 29 (Project #430849-1) No Update.






