


IMPORTANT INFO FOR SCHOOLS & SYSTEMS

THE STEVE CARTER LITERACY TUTORING PROGRAM PROVIDES \$1,000 DIGITAL VOUCHERS TO FAMILIES OF ELIGIBLE K-5 PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS. FAMILIES USE THESE VOUCHERS TO PURCHASE HIGH-QUALITY LITERACY TUTORING SERVICES.

THE REGISTRATION PORTAL IS NOW OPEN AT LOUISIANATUTORINGINITIATIVE.COM.

Beginning in January, the Louisiana Department of Education will launch a statewide promotional campaign that will include television, radio, and online advertising.

The following information and resources are available to help systems and schools ensure their families can take advantage of this new opportunity.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Any Louisiana public school student in grades K-3 who scored below proficiency on the beginning of the year literacy screener
- Any Louisiana public school student in grades 4-5 who scored below mastery in the ELA portion of LEAP in the spring of 2022

WHAT IS NEEDED FROM SYSTEMS AND/OR SCHOOLS?

- Schools will identify eligible students and send a letter to families stating eligibility. This letter should include the student's Louisiana Department of Education Student ID.
- The letter schools will send home to families includes the web address to the online registration portal and registration directions.
- Schools and systems can help promote the program on communications channels.
