Collooney Church Conservation Update: Scaffolding is due to be erected at parts of the church early next week. Apologies, in advance, for any inconvenience this may cause. It is hoped that these essential repair works will make the building waterproof and allow it to dry out. The work is scheduled to last up to three months.

As previously advised, three separate grants have already been secured. In addition, the monthly yellow conservation envelopes have been very well supported. Other separate individual donations have also added significantly to the local contribution. A huge Thank You to all for your tremendous support, especially during these difficult economic times when most families are challenged by cost of living expenses. Thanks, also, for the invaluable help of the Church Conservation and Church Finance committees who are overseeing the project.

Despite the grant aid, and the tremendous response to the Conservation fund, there will still be a shortfall of approximately €32,000.00 which we will have to raise. Again, many thanks for your ongoing generosity and support.
