# Reopening Requirements

- Requirements are in place to protect everyone from you. Asymptomatic or pre-symptomatic people are 80% of the total infected population.
- Orange chairs are all in storage. 21 Folding metal chairs are in the three rooms.
- Floors are marked for 6-foot distancing of chairs.
- Restrooms are all open and sanitized several times an hour during work hours on workdays.
- Our requirements are determined by State, county and Sheppard Pratt requirements outlined in the sign in the hallway as you enter Agape off the elevator.

# Sheppard Pratt/Baltimore County - Covid 19 Reopening Requirements for Agape Meetings

## ***Proceeding to an Agape meeting room is your acceptance of all Covid 19 risks and agreement to the following:***

- If you are an older adult or you have one or more chronic health conditions, do not proceed.
- Cleaning is the responsibility of all Agape members as part of their compliance with Covid 19 orders currently in effect in Maryland, Baltimore County and Sheppard Pratt. We leave our meeting room Covid-clean for the next meeting.
  - Wear face coverings whenever face-to-face interaction takes place.
  - Social distancing is required.
  - Frequent disinfection of meeting surfaces and objects touched by multiple people is required. Supplies are provided.
- Maximum seating for Covid 19 reopening:
  - Front room (Rooms 331/332): 6 people
  - Large room (Rooms 384/385/386): 10 people
  - Small room (Rooms 388): 5 people
- Lunchroom (across from large room) is not Agape meeting space
- Agape meetings are in the leased space inside the Gibson Building (not outside).
- Maryland requires cooperation with contact tracing. Please enter your contact information at [aa-agape.org](http://aa-agape.org) in order to notify you if someone in a meeting you attended is diagnosed with Covid 19.
- Violators of Covid 19 orders are subject to up to 1 year in jail, \$5,000 fine, or both, in the state of Maryland.



# Determine Agape meeting conduct by Group Conscience vote.

1. The Maryland, Baltimore County and Sheppard Pratt Covid requirements will be followed (described in the hallway sign). Walking past the hall sign, entering a meeting room is agreement to follow the requirements?
2. The secretary for each meeting will be determined by the attending members?
3. If someone enters the room without a mask, the secretary and the meeting participants will ask the person to put on a mask (or leave)?
4. If people will not comply with social distancing and respect room capacity limitations, the secretary and the meeting participants will ask the person(s) to leave?
5. If a newcomer cannot get into a room because of capacity limitations, a meeting member will exchange phone numbers with the newcomer in the hallway?
6. If a person refuses to wear a mask or comply with social distancing, and refuses to leave, the meeting should be ended?
7. Coffee and snacks will not be provided?
8. Literature and directories will not be available?
9. Readings for meeting will be brought to the meeting by the secretary. (If not how?)
10. The donations basket will be carried around the room, put in an envelope and in the safe by one person in the meeting. (If not how?)
