Entries utilizing martial arts or gymnastics (including cheer stunts) must use appropriate protective gear and trained adult "spotters". Entries with live animals must maintain control of them at all times. NO ENTRY may enter the parade route more than one time for competition regardless of changes in name or appearance.
