PARADE RULES

-Any cancellations or withdrawals after May 25th, 2019 will not be refunded. NO parade day entries will be allowed. All entries must be submitted before Thursday, May 30th, 2019.

-CHECK-IN TABLE will be located on the corner of West Las Palmas Avenue and 9th Street. Check-in on parade day starts at 7:00am. All entries are to be checked in no later than 8:30am. Any entries not checked-in on time may be relocated in the line-up to the end of the parade.

-PARADE ASSEMBLY time is 8:00am. Failure to be in position by 9:00am may result in a reassignment in the line-up.

-FORWARD MOTION PARADE: Each Entry must maintain general forward motion throughout the entire Parade Route, with at least one member of the unit maintaining a forward movement at all times. Failure to maintain forward motion at all time throughout the Parade Route may result in being disqualified and /or removal from parade.

-PARADE ROUTE must be completed by all units. Failure to comply will result in disqualification. Delays in parade route will be disqualified and/or removed from the parade. A parade marshal will be at the end of the parade route to check off your entry.

-FIFTY (50) feet spacing is required between units. This is for safety. Please do not make it more than 50 feet or will cause delays in parade.

-SAFETY FIRST- For the safety of both participants and spectators: No objects are to be thrown, sprayed, or discharged in any way or at any time along the parade route. No loaded weapons or discharging of firearms will be allowed. No use of fire, fireworks or other pyrotechnics will be allowed. No alcoholic beverage of any type will be allowed. No tobacco or related products will be allowed. All living things on a moving entry must be secured. No one is allowed to ride on the running boards, roofs or fenders. Entries utilizing martial arts or gymnastics (including cheer stunts) must use appropriate protective gear and trained adult "spotters". Entries with live animals must maintain control of them at all times. NO ENTRY may enter the parade route more than one time for competition regardless of changes in name or appearance. No type of abusive language or signs will be allowed.

-EQUESTRIAN ENTRY-there is a maximum of **20 HORSES per group**, or may result in disqualification and/or removal. Entries with live animals must maintain control of them at all times

-CAR CLUBS-there is a maximum of **20 vehicles per car club**, or may result in disqualification and/or removal. -All vehicle drivers must have clear unobstructed visibility and hold a valid Driver's License. All tires must remain in contact with the pavement at all times. All drivers must obey the California Vehicle Code.

-POLITICAL ENTRIES- Candidate must be present in person with/on entry through entire parade route or their fee will be double.

-UNITS with sound or unusual noise must so indicate on entry form. Failure will result in penalty in competition.

******The parade committee reserves the right of final decision on entries. The committee reserves the right to bar from the parade, at any time, an entry not conforming to these rules and regulations, or refusing to follow instructions of law enforcement or parade officials.**
