# Hybrid Learning!!!!

Thanks to **IHS** for vaccinating the Nespelem staff, Hybrid Learning started on March 24<sup>th</sup> from 8 am to 2 pm (Group B).

K- 4<sup>th</sup> grades are divided into two cohorts. Cohort A comes on Mondays & Cohort B comes on Wednesdays.

Transportation has divide the grades by neighborhood routes (Mondays: New HUD, Old HUD, Town, Gold Lake Rd., HWY 155, OWHI / Wednesdays: Colleens, Agency, White Buffalo, Joe Moses, Charlie Williams Rd.). This means your student will need to be picked up and dropped off at the same location. You will be notified of your assigned cohort and bus pick-up time. Please answer any calls you see from the school!

If you drop your student off at school, please wait until 7:45 am, as due to COVID restrictions we will not have staff available to watch them before that time. Remember that your student must wear a mask & cannot bring a backpack. Do not bring chromebooks; we have one reserved at the building for your student.

If you pick your child up after school, please park behind the flag pole, next to the curb and we will bring them out to you. If you must come in the building, please sign in at the health table in the foyer, wearing a mask and then proceed into the office where we will be waiting to help you.

Remote learning will continue to be at least one of the choices available to all families for the rest of the year. Please see the Hybrid Learning Template and the COVID Guidelines for further detailed information. In order to keep our school doors open, we are required to follow these guidelines.

In order for your child to return on campus when it opens, you will need to turn in all necessary paperwork beforehand. This includes Attestation, Health History, Immunizations, & Health Care Plans. If you are uncertain of your status in this area, please call the office: 509-634-4541.

## Lunches:

Lunches and learning packets continue to be delivered Monday through Thursday, weekly. These will continue through April 21<sup>st</sup> (except during spring break). Students who are on campus for in person learning will also receive lunch while they are at the school, as well as their packets, but we ask that you feed them breakfast until April 22<sup>nd</sup>. We are not allowed to "double-dip". After the 21<sup>st</sup>, packets must be picked up on Mondays (K-4) or Tuesdays (5-8) at the school if your student does not attend in-person learning.
