### ARE YOU HOMELESS OR AT RISK OF LOSING YOUR HOUSING?

To access homeless/housing crisis services, everyone must complete a Coordinated Entry (CE) Assessment. CE is a process to assess, prioritize and connect people who are experiencing a housing crisis to resources that will prevent or end their homelessness.
