Code of Conduct:

Respect the patches you have earned and the sisterhood they represent. When any SHWRC logos are present be aware you are representing the club and ensure your conduct is appropriate.

1. The SHWRC Membership code is to be observed: Family first, Work second, Club third.
2. All Members are to be kind and respectful of all sisters, prospects, and their supporters.
3. Do not show disrespect of unacceptable behavior on social media or in public.
4. Members will not discuss club business outside of the riding club.
5. Members are never to leave their vests left unattended as they are to be treated with care and respect. Do not hand your vest to anyone other than a full patched member of SHWRC.
6. Do not wear your vest while sitting in vehicles other than motorcycles, unless approved by the President or Vice President or Regional/Chapter Director.
7. Members shall not take any attitude or dress in a fashion that would mistake them for a 1% club.
8. All members will treat each sister's husband, boyfriend, significant other, and family members with respect.
9. No member will engage in a romantic relationship with any sister's husband, boyfriend or significant other. Doing so will be grounds for immediate termination of membership.

If you witness or are yourself the target of verbal or physical abuse, or hear judgmental remarks based on race, sexual orientation, or any personal attacks by another member of Steel Hearts WRC, you should report it to the National President and National MSAA directly. If the issue cannot be resolved with the offender, they will be asked to leave the group and will lose their Steel Hearts WRC membership privileges, including but not limited to: rides, events, Facebook group membership, and website member profile.

We do not encourage drinking and riding and have a "zero tolerance" policy for illegal drugs during Steel Hearts WRC events. We expect that you will be respectful and responsible for your safety and the safety of others. We reserve the right to terminate membership if safety standards are not observed.
