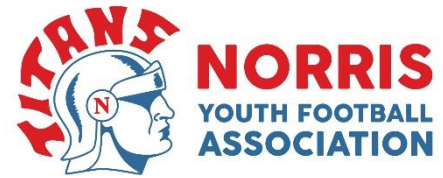


## Player School and Grades Expectations



Our program has established guiding principles that we will emphasize and teach our players.

- Football skills
- Discipline
- Team before self
- School Spirit
- Education

The list above is no particular order, but we do strive to highlight **Education** above the others. Education is the foundation that these players will use for the rest of their lives. Football will eventually fade away, but the impact of education will last a lifetime. We have several expectations that we discuss with our players concerning school.

- Grades – You must maintain a C+ average or better in all subjects to be eligible to practice or play.
- School conduct – We expect all players to conduct themselves with honor. Each player represents Norris Youth Football, and we want to establish a high standard of conduct. We expect players to treat other students, teachers, and staff with respect.

All of this is self-reported with communications from parents. We want to work with each family to make sure school is a priority and each player's grades don't slip.

As part of the emphasizing good conduct, we also have a **Good Grades** program. Periodically throughout the season we will ask for players to bring proof of an **A / 90% or better** on a test, exam, paper, or spelling test. Proof can be done via paper or mobile device. Each player that provides proof of a **Good Grade** will receive **one Norris Titan Token**. A player may receive a **Norris Titan Token** once a week and the token may be redeemed at any Norris High School or Norris Youth Football Concession stand during the school year for anything up to the value of \$1.00.
