

Plymouth County 4-H Open Horse Show:

Division Specs

LEADLINE 8 & UNDER (3, 4, 45)

To be ridden at the walk and the trot. Open to children 8 years of age and younger. Limited to riders who have never ridden in a walk/trot division.

LEADLINE 9 & OVER (5, 6, 46)

To be ridden at the walk and the trot. Open to exhibitors 9 years of age and older. Limited to riders who have never ridden in a walk/trot division.

THERAPEUTIC (7, 8, 47)

To be ridden at the walk and trot. Open to all individuals who take therapeutic riding instruction, no age restriction.

SMALL EQUINE (2, 9, 42, 48)

Open to equines 12 hands and under. Exhibitors are to show in-hand in this division.

WALK TROT 9 & UNDER (10, 13, 49)

To be ridden at the walk and trot only. Open to riders 9 years of age and under. Limited to those who have never shown at the canter. FOR SAFETY REASONS WALK TROT ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY CANTERING DIVISIONS.

WALK TROT 10-12 (11, 14, 50)

To be ridden at the walk and the trot only. Open to riders 10 years of age to 12 years of age. Limited to those who have never shown at the canter. FOR SAFETY REASONS WALK TROT ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY CANTERING DIVISIONS..

WALK TROT 13-17 (12, 15, 51)

To be ridden at the walk and the trot only. Open to riders 13 years of age to 17 years of age. Limited to those who have never shown at the canter. FOR SAFETY REASONS WALK TROT ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY CANTERING DIVISIONS.

4-H JUNIOR WT (1B, 16, 20, 52)

To be ridden at the walk and the trot only. Limited to 4-H junior members (8yr-13yr) who have not shown at the canter and who have had their project animals for at least 3 months. Open to all seats. FOR SAFETY REASONS WALK TROT ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY CANTERING DIVISIONS.

4-H SENIOR WT (1C, 17, 21, 53)

To be ridden at the walk and the trot only. Limited to 4-H senior members (14yr-18yr) who have not shown at the canter and who have had their project animals for at least 3 months. Open to all seats. FOR SAFETY REASONS WALK TROT ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY CANTERING DIVISIONS.

GREEN HORSE (19, 22, 54)

To be ridden at the walk and the trot. Limited to horses in their first and second year of showing. Green horses can only be ridden in the green horse division. FOR SAFETY REASONS WALK TROT ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY CANTERING DIVISIONS.

BEGINNER WTC (23, 27, 55)

To be ridden at the walk, trot and canter by those riders in their FIRST year of cantering. Entries may not cross over into any other division. Entries will be asked to canter four (4) riders on the rail at one time.

PONY (4, 18, 28, 38)

To be ridden at the walk, trot and canter. Open seat. Ponies must be 14.2 hands or under. Open to riders 18 years of age and under. FOR SAFETY REASONS WTC ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY WALK TROT DIVISIONS.

OPEN JUNIOR (25, 29, 57)

To be ridden at the walk, trot and canter. Open to riders from the ages of 8 years old to 13 years old. Open to all seats. FOR SAFETY REASONS WTC ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY WALK TROT DIVISIONS.

OPEN SENIOR (26, 30, 58)

To be ridden at the walk, trot and canter. Open to riders from the ages of 14 years old to 18 years old. Open to all seats. FOR SAFETY REASONS WTC ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY WALK TROT DIVISIONS.

4-H JUNIOR (1B, 31, 34, 59)

To be ridden at the walk, trot and canter. Limited to 4-H junior members (8yr-13yr) and who have had their project animals for at least 3 months. Open to all seats. FOR SAFETY REASONS WTC ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY WALK TROT DIVISIONS.

4-H SENIOR (1C, 32, 35, 60)

To be ridden at the walk, trot and canter. Limited to 4-H senior members (14yr-18yr) and who have had their project animals for at least 3 months. Open to all seats. FOR SAFETY REASONS WTC ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY WALK TROT DIVISIONS.

4-H ALUMNI (33, 36, 61)

To be ridden at the walk, trot and canter. Limited to 4-H alumni that have aged out of the program. Open to all seats. FOR SAFETY REASONS WTC ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY WALK TROT DIVISIONS.

WT GAMES (37, 38, 40, 43)

To be shown at the walk and the trot only. Open to all seats. Spectators and grooms is open to all spectators. Sit-a-buck wins half the entry fees for the class. FOR SAFETY REASONS WALK TROT ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY CANTERING DIVISIONS.

WTC GAMES (39, 41, 44)

To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Open to all seats. Sit-a-buck wins half the entry fees for the class. FOR SAFETY REASONS WTC ENTRIES MAY NOT CROSS OVER INTO ANY WALK TROT DIVISIONS.

***ALL WALK TROT DIVISIONS:**

Once you receive seven blue ribbons, you must move up to WTC the following show season.
