Subject: Regarding the Proposed Affidavits

Dear Mrs. Degnan,

I hope this email finds you well. I am writing to inform you that after careful consideration, I have decided not to sign the affidavits you have prepared. Adk make it clear that my staff will also not be signing these documents.

I want to clarify several points regarding this decision:

1. As a general rule, we do not sign documents that we have not created ourselves. This is to ensure that we fully understand and agree with every aspect attesting to.
2. In Connecticut homeschool programs, school districts do not typically sign affidavits or similar documents for our students. This is not a standard practice in CT homeschooling approach.
3. I remain deeply confused about the purpose of these affidavits. It's entirely unclear to me why they are necessary or what specific need they are meant to address in the context of our homeschooling program. This lack of understanding is a significant factor in our decision.
4. This decision extends to all members of my staff. None of us will be signing these affidavits.

Given these concerns, neither I nor my staff feel comfortable signing these documents. I cannot emphasize enough how puzzled I am by the need for the documents to could provide more information about their purpose and necessity, I would be very interested in understanding the rationale behind them.

If you have any questions or would like to clarify the situation, please don't hesitate to contact me. I'm open to further discussion to resolve this confusion.

Thank you for reaching out about your son's education. I appreciate your dedication to ensuring his academic progress is properly recognized. I understand to have validation of your child's hard work and achievements.

I want to address your request for a review and report card from the Board of Education with honesty and empathy. While I sincerely wish we could provide for, I regret to say that it's not something we're able to do for homeschooled students.

In Connecticut, homeschooling is recognized as a form of private education. This means that public schools, including our district in Plainfield, don't have evaluate or issue grades for students who aren't enrolled in our system. This separation is actually designed to protect the freedom and flexibility that make homeschooling.

I know this might not be the answer you were hoping for, and I'm truly sorry if it causes any frustration or disappointment. Please know that this doesn't in value of your son's education or your efforts as a homeschooling parent.

While we can't provide official grades or report cards, there are other ways you can document and validate your son's progress:

- - Keeping detailed records of his work and achievements
- - Looking into standardized testing options for homeschoolers
- - Exploring evaluation services offered by homeschool organizations

If you're considering a change in your son's educational path, we'd be more than happy to discuss options for enrolling in our public schools. In that case Education would certainly be involved in overseeing his education.
