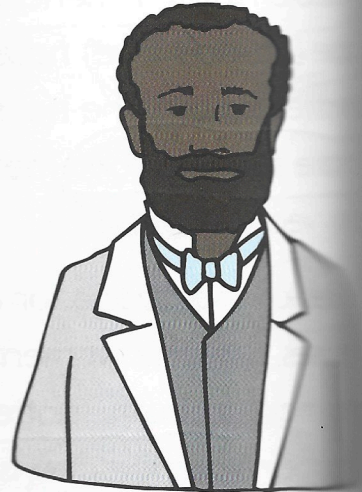

## A Visit to Venus

For many years, no one knew much about Venus. When people looked through telescopes, they could not see past Venus's clouds. Long ago, people thought the clouds covered living things. Spacecraft radar has shown that this is not true. Venus is too hot for life to exist. The temperature on Venus is about 900 degrees! Remember how hot you were the last time it was 90 degrees? Now, imagine it being 10 times hotter. Nothing could exist in that heat. It is also very dry on Venus. For life to exist, water must be present. Because of the heat and dryness, we know that there are no people, plants, or other life on Venus.
