#### Water

Riverside SUD has a website: <a href="www.riversidewatersupply.com">www.riversidewatersupply.com</a> that you may visit to see any current issues. You can subscribe to have news, notices, and alerts delivered via email or text. Just another way they are working to better serve our community.

During this time of year our weather fluctuates frequently. It may be necessary to turn off your water at the main meter and drain your pipes to avoid any pipe damage. A lot of property owners are not full time so it would be ideal if you made this a practice when you are going to be away.

#### **San Jacinto County Animal Regulations**

Section IV – M states:

"PUBLIC NUISANCE" shall describe any animal that:

- 1. Continually barks or other noise making;
- 2. Soils, defiles or feceates on a public walk or recreation area and the owner does not immediately remove such waste; or
- 3. Chases or pursues pedestrians, cyclists, or vehicles.

Additionally, San Jacinto County does have a leash law. All animals must be restrained at all times. If you have any issues with this you may contact the Animal Control Deputy at (936) 653-4367 and ask for a deputy to be dispatched.

#### Other

Please observe, and follow, speed limit signs in the neighborhood. All roads in the subdivision are 30mph.

Please remember that the discharge of firearms within the subdivision is strictly prohibited on all lots at all times. The discharge of firearms may also be unlawful.

Please notify the Association of any street lights out or not working properly. (936) 222-5732.

#### NON-EMERGENCY & NON-MEDICAL HELP NEEDS

Residents of Lakeside Village: If you have a non-emergency, non-medical need for help for someone who has fallen and can't get up without assistance, please call 911 and <u>tell</u> the dispatcher you are located in San Jacinto County and that you have a non-emergency and non-medical need for a lift assist, and you are requesting the 980 North Fire Department located in the subdivision to be toned out to provide assistance.

By having the fire department assist in these cases, it will help free up the medical emergency responders who have more serious calls to attend.

#### ROAD HAZARDS

Property owners who observe a hazard on any road in Lakeside Village may notify the Association (936) 222-5732, or contact the Commissioner directly (936) 377-2481. *All roads in Lakeside Village are county maintained and not privately owned.* 

#### ARCHITECTURAL APPROVAL

Please get the Association's approval <u>before</u> placing new storage buildings, homes, and home add-ons, etc. on your lot. All applications have to be submitted to the Association's Architectural Committee for approval. Applications are available upon request and the process is simple. Please call the Association if you need any clarification (936-222-5732). Please remember to check with the San Jacinto County Permit Office if you plan to add a structure on your property. They will advise if a permit is needed. The number for the SJC permit office is (936) 653-3823.
