



Frost Delay Procedure

Frost delays are necessary to protect the long term health and playability of our course, especially the greens surfaces. Monitored daily and the ultimate decision of the Superintendent and communicated through the website and golf shop staff.

In order to protect the turf and allow maximum access when conditions allow, below is an outline of the Frost Delay Procedure on days where low temperatures and daylight time require a delay.

- First tee time: 8:30am
 - o Superintendent to assess course conditions by 6:30am each morning
 - o Home page of the website will be updated with course conditions
 - o Email will be sent to the days tee sheet with updated course conditions
- If there is a need for frost delay but a decision can be made immediately, all play will begin an 11:30am SHOTGUN for all players booked that day
- If there is a need for frost delay but further inspection/progress is needed to make a decision on allowing access the next update will come via same channels (website and email) by 10:00am.
- The final decision for the day will be made at 10:00am from the following options.
 - 1) Facilitate an 11:30am shotgun
 - 2) No shotgun but be available for walk in's only after 2:00pm (9 holes)
 - 3) Remain closed for the rest of the day

**** Golf shop will do its best to facilitate golfers arriving outside of these times but access can not be guaranteed. If you intend to golf outside of the posted daily decision please call golf shop before****
