Position Summary

The Ledgeview Golf Club is seeking an energetic, professional, motivated, and experienced individual to join our course maintenance team to care for and maintain selected landscape sites on the golf course. This individual will be an integral part in helping to beautify and enhance aesthetics in a sustainable and environmentally friendly way. They will also be asked to perform some regular maintenance duties required to maintain golf course playing conditions on some occasions. This position reports to the Golf Course Superintendent and is seasonal between the months of March and October.

Role and Responsibilities

- Assists with the design and construction of landscape improvement projects as needed by the Superintendent
- Operate various types of turf related equipment
- Perform all duties necessary from the care and maintenance of ornamental plants and shrubs on the clubhouse selected course sites. Operates associated equipment needed for these tasks
- Perform some regular maintenance practices as directed by the Superintendent
- prepare soil plant beds, establish by seed or transplants and maintain annual and perennial flowers in aesthetic arrangements. Plant and maintain ornamental shrubs and trees which includes appropriate pruning, trimming, feeding and pest control.

Compensation and Benefits
