



To the Juniors of the Ledgeview Golf Club,

We are BACK with another Race To the Honda Way Cup, a season long junior-night league.

Let's Golf *Where Legends Are Born!*

This league is open to both junior members and non-members and will commence on Tuesday June 13th at 4:00pm. All Juniors can book up to 7 days in advance. Juniors must contact the golf shop to put their names in the tee sheet for the following week.

All of our golfers must be able to walk and play 9 holes without supervision. Our junior nights are ideally for golfers age 11 and older, but if a younger junior meets our standards of play, we will certainly welcome them! There is no cost to play for members, and a \$35 green fee for non-members.

When Does It Start?

At 4:00pm, a contest or group activity will take place so we recommend that you arrive at 4:00pm every Tuesday no matter what your tee time may be. The tee times will begin at 4:30pm.



We will be separating the flights into these skill levels:

The Novice Division - From 150 yards and in

For golfers who have little on-course experience

The Intermediate Division - Red Tees

For golfers who can shoot a score of 50 or lower on nine holes

The Competitive Division - White Tees

For golfers who can shoot a score of 42 or lower on nine holes

The Advanced Division - Blue Tees

For golfers who can shoot a score of 36 or lower on nine holes

Golfers will 'graduate' into respective categories. For example, if a golfer in the **Intermediate** Division shoots a score of 42, they will graduate to the **Competitive** Division for the rest of the season.

What's Up For Grabs?

A season-long points system will decide the winner of The Race to the Honda Way Cup. The season-long winner will win a junior membership for the following season and gift card prizes are up for grabs each week. A player from any division has the possibility of winning this coveted prize, the Race to the Honda Way Cup Champion.

The Top 20 Juniors in the Race to the Honda Way Cup will qualify for our season ending Honda Way Battle, where Team Callaway will compete against Team Taylormade for Ledgeview Glory.



Points System

Points will be given on each junior night as follows

Participation: 15 points

1st place in Division: 50 points

2nd place in Division: 25 points

3rd place in Division: 10 points

Skills Prize Winner (KPs, Long Drive, Long Putt): 10 points each

Elevated Events

This year we will have four elevated events: June 13th, July 4th, September 5th, and September 12th. On these nights additional points and gift card prizes are up for grabs.
