2019 RACING PROGRAM & SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

2019 brings new opportunities to experience the WIR Dragstrip like you have never before. New timing equipment, 13 rounds of bracket races, 8 Quik 8 Competitions, more Test and Tune, more Street Drags, 1st Annual Ghost Rods Barn Door Bash for vehicles 1966 and older and our 2nd Annual No Prep Event. Our traditional dragstrip specials in June, July and August will continue and boast Fan Pit walks, driver introductions and more fan interaction.

In September 2018 we selected and acquired an Accutime Timing System. Installation included high quality wiring, connectors, brackets, photocells, tree construction and state of the art timer box. The system provides four decimal place (0.0001) readout on all times (win margin, R.T., and E.T.). as well as built-in noise suppression for trouble-free system operation. Bracket racers attest with Accutime they are able to consistently hit the tree and their dial-ins, better and tighter than with any other system.

Cate Fees and Race Entry prices will remain the same in 2019 with one change. Hot Rod Eliminator entry fee will increase to \$60 and result in increased payout schedule.

All bracket racing will continue to be 1/4 mile, with Juniors running 1/8 mile.

IHRA SUMMIT SUPER SERIES BRACKET RACING

The 2019 Bracket Drag Racing Program has 13 scheduled rounds. All rounds will count towards total points calculation.

New in 2019 – IHRA Sportsman class open to door cars only (12.00 & slower in the ¼-mile and 7.50 & slower in the 1/8-mile). The use of trans brakes, two steps, and delay boxes are prohibited in the Sportsman class. The IHRA Sportsman class will be WIR's Street Eliminator class.

Bracket Racing is available to IHRA members and non members. Non members are eligible to win WIR class championships. IHRA competition requires membership and X points number.

IHRA Summit SuperSeries X points will go to the track champion in each class. This applies to Top Eliminator/Box and Hot Rod/Modified and Street/Sportsman classes.

Motorcycles wishing to participation in the X Points program will need to choose either Top, Modified or Sportsman class to be eligible for the X points championship.

The final points race will be September, 28, 2019.

QUIK 8 COMPETITION RULES

- 1. Door Cars Only.
- 2. Car/Driver must be entered in Summit Super Series to race in Quik 8.
- 3. Entries will be determined from 2 qualifying passes in all classes.
- 4. \$10 Entry Fee per race.
- 5. All run on 4 tenths Pro Tree.
- 6. All cars will have a dial in. Must be within .10 of your qualifying ET.
- 7. All WIR & IHRA safety rules in effect. Chassis certification and license required on all cars running 9.00 & quicker.
- 8. You MUST make the call to run. Get in lanes and get there quickly when called.
- 9. If you win and cannot make the next round the driver that lost to you will be reinstated. NO FREE rounds. Two cars will always run in this class.
- 10. If you win and cannot make it to the next round, it is your responsibility to contact the other driver or contact Randy O'Keefe or Myron Mertens in the pits.
- 11. Weekly winnings and points chase. 1 point for qualifying, 1 point for each round win.
- 12. Team drivers same rules as WIR.
- 13. Pairings and lane choice will be on a rotation of card draw or ladder. Determined based on the ET of cars that day.
- 14. Meet at announced locations immediately following qualifying to determine pairings. Get there quickly.
- 15. Payout Winner \$350 , Runner up \$150.
- 16. If rain out, Quik 8 moves to next available event.
