- TC cars race amongst slow-moving “Highway 41 traffic”
- All cars race together. Big cars start (1) lap down.
- Race format:
 - <20 cars, one race, 10 laps.
 - 20+ cars, odd/even qualifiers 5 laps, top 5 transfer to 10-lap final.
- All doors must be welded or chained.
- All personal safety equipment required.

- All doors must be welded or chained.
- All personal safety equipment required.

Obstacle Course – Big/Small Car – \$20 Entry Fee 🏆🏆

- Cars are divided into Big and Small car classes. Race format:
 - <16 cars, one race, 5 laps.
 - 16+ cars, two 3-lap qualifiers, top 4 advance to 8-car 5-lap final race.
- All doors must be welded or chained.
- All personal safety equipment required.
- Drivers must yield at the X to prevent a driver's side hit.

 - 27-lap main event. Invert 8 + roll.
