Exploration in Drawing Instructor: Clay James

Description: In this course we will cover the basic principles of drawing. This will cover the four basic shapes, the use of line, the use of pencil, pen and charcoal, chiaroscuro, basic perspective, and composition.

8 week session One-3hr. Session per week Sundays 2-5

Week 1 Introduction to materials:

This will include the use of pen, pencil and charcoal and the surface for Which they are used.

HOMEWORK: 3- DRAWINGS EACH WITH PEN, PENCIL AND CHARCOAL. Keep to simple single objects.

Week 2 Working with line:

Focus will be on line variety and qualities. We will explore line, outline, and Contour line.

HOMEWORK: 3 DRAWINGS INCORPORATING ALL LINE QUALITIES AND VARIETIES

Week 3 Working with shape:

Focus will be on shape and space. An understanding of postive and negative space and geometric and organic shapes through guided exercises is the desired outcome.

HOMEWORK: 3 DRAWINGS INCORPORATING AND DEFINING SHAPE.

Week 4 Working with value:

Focus will be on the use of value as it relates to defining edge and form. Work will concentrate on value as it relates to hard, soft and blended Edges.

HOMEWORK: 3 DRAWINGS WORKING WITH ALL EDGES

Week 5 Chiaroscuro:

Focus is on the use of a value scale in affecting a more realistic drawing. Attention will be paid on highlight, light, midtone, shadow, cast shadow and reflected light.

HOMEWORK: DRAWINGS, ONE WITH A SINGLE OBJECT, ONE WITH AT LEAST 3 OBJECTS AND FABRIC.

Week 6 Working with perspective:

An introduction to the technique and use of perspective. HOMEWORK: 3 DRAWINGS ONE OF EACH PERSPECTIVE SYSTEM.

Week 7 Composition:

Emphasis will be on arrangement of simple objects into a composition.
HOMEWORK: FINALS 3 DRAWINGS 1) PEN/INK 9 X 12 INCH
2) PENCIL/GRAPHITE 11 X 14 INCH, 3) CHARCOAL 18 X 24 INCH
