Renters are not allowed to operate NewtonPAC’s technical equipment. Rentals will not have access to equipment not detailed in rental contract. More than one House Manager may be required at the discretion of NewtonPAC. A \$250.00 deposit is required to hold your rental date(s). This deposit is refundable 30 days after the event date (or last date for multiple dates) provided all rental obligations have been met and there has been no damage to the facility caused by the event.
