"So then let us not sleep, as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober." (1 Thessalonians 5:6)

From 2010-2016, our church in Indianapolis (Burge Terrace) hosted the 3G Youth Conference, standing for God's *glory, gospel, and grace*. Each year we themed the youth conference on one of the "G's" as we sought to make much of Christ. Our first conference (2010) was about God's glory.

A few years earlier, I had written a poem on God's awakening our hearts in revival, but it had been buried as other themes came to mind. As we approached our inaugural 3G Youth Conference, I wanted a new song on revival and God's glory, and so I found the original text and incorporated new ideas into the hymn. We introduced the song at the conference, thus beginning a tradition of writing a new hymn for each of the seven conferences we would eventually host.
