What is Hospice?

- Ol Care for patients with a prognosis of six months or less to live
- O2 Hospice is centered with providing comfort and quality of life interventions
- O3 Care can be six months or longer with a physician certification regarding life expectancy
- 04 Patient need not be homebound
- O5 Care available in patient's home, group homes and in skilled nursing facilities
- Medicare, Medi-Cal and most private insurance plans cover hospice care, medications, supplies, DME
- O7 Hospice focuses on family/caregiver support through bereavement counseling, respite care
- **08** Requires physician order
- OS Hospice care costs less than hospital or facility care
- 10 Hospice care can be intermittent or based on continuous care
- Hospice care team includes RN, LVN, CNA,
 Medical Social Worker, Chaplain, Hospice Aides,
 Volunteers, and Rehabilitation Services
