What is Skilled Home Health Care?

- Skilled care for acute conditions, chroninc conditions or recovery from a surgical procedure or an injury
- Pocus is to rehabilitate or help patients to recover functional status
- Paients are seen for 9 week episodes with recertification of 9 weeks depending on patient's medical status and doctor's orders
- Patient must be homebound, requires a doctor's face to face visit, and a doctor's order
- Skilled care is only available in patient's home and in group homes such as RCFEs, not in SNFs
- Skilled services are covered but not medications, DME or non-skilled services such as caregivers
- 7 Skilled care focused on patient, family, caregiver education
- Home health team includes RN, LVN, CHHA, Medical Social Worker, Physical Therapist, Occupational Therapist, and Speech Therapist
- g Skilled Home health care is intermittent care with the exception of shift care services
- Medicare Part A or Part B and most private insurances cover skilled home health care
