Greetings, Brothers & Sisters in Christ!

March is the month we start looking forward to spring weather, but we can have a range of temperatures. Besides the rollercoaster weather we might have, it is also the time to set our clocks ahead an hour on March 8, so you get up in time for church on March 9!

On March 5th we have the Ash Wednesday service in Strawberry Point at 5:30 pm. We will also offer ashes on Sunday, March 9 at the 9:00 am Aurora Sunday Service. Instead of a weekly Lenten Study, this year we will make a commitment to meet with God each day of the Lenten Season with a daily devotional "The Sanctuary for Lent 2025." This devotional guide contains readings for each day in Lent, from Ash Wednesday through Easter Sunday, including a suggested Scripture, a short devotion, and a brief prayer. You will have the opportunity to open yourself daily to God. There are printed devotionals or you can download the devotional. I will post a question or thought each day for you to think about or respond to if you would like to participate.

On March 13, we will host a meeting for local clergy, lay leaders and other members of communities to meet with a non-profit organization from the Des Moines area called AMOS (A Midlowa Organizing Strategy). They have been present in central lowa for several years and have been instrumental in teaching communities how to organize effectively to meet the needs of their communities. And don't forget to celebrate St. Patrick's Day or the Feast of Saint Patrick on March 17th. This is a

religious and cultural holiday held to commemorate the arrival of Christianity in Ireland

On March 23rd Strawberry Point UMC will host another BINGO get together. Join us for a free will lunch and then play Bingo for some fun prizes and fellowship! No cost to play! On March 24th we will have a Joint SPRC meeting with representatives from all three churches at 5:30 at Strawberry Point UMC following the Strawberry Church Council Meeting. I will also be attending the Iowa Conference Spring Orders & Fellowship Meeting at Lovely Lane UMC in Cedar Rapids on March 27th. On March 30th we will have a joint worship service at 10:00 AM at Lamont UMC with a potluck after. SPRC/AD Council Meeting

February 10, 2025 - Our meeting began with prayer offered by Pastor Lisa. Pastor reviewed her activities. Vacation for the spring dates of April 28-May 12 were proposed. Pulpit supply would be needed for May 4 and 11. Jerry Griffin will supply May 11.

A new program, AMOS, was discussed. A Mid-lowa Organizing Strategy (AMOS). The circuit group pastors will meet to plan an activity in the future.

Lenten devotional books will be offered in place of a Lenten study.

Insurance for Grace church will include a \$600 increase in premium cost.






