We would like to invite you to participate in this fun filled weekend that will be attended by trappers, hunters, fishermen and outdoor enthusiasts alike from the Thunder Bay district as well as throughout Northwestern Ontario. The weekend consists of displays, demonstrations, pelt handling competitions, a Friday evening social and auction, and a smorgasbord and dance on Saturday evening.

Display hours are as follows:
Friday, March 1st - 11:00 a.m. - 5 p.m.
Saturday, March 2nd - 9:30 a.m. - 3 p.m.

Displays must be set up by 10:30 a.m. on Friday. The display area will be closed after the hours listed above. Overnight security will be provided. Dismantling will be done after 3 p.m. on Saturday. The N.W.F.T.A. will not be responsible for any materials not removed at that time. Displays must have someone in attendance at all times.

Participants have the choice of floor space for your own display unit, or an assembled booth consisting of one 8' wide back wall and 4' depth - side walls. Items may be affixed to the walls. Floor space will be based on the same footage, but can be adjusted to suit.

Booth Cost: 3 Options Available

Single (8' wide backwall x 4' depth) \$50.00 / **Double** (16' wide backwall x 4' depth) \$100.00

Floor Space with tables (for boats/quads) \$100.00

Each space will be provided with a table and chairs. Electrical outlets are on first come, first served basis. Space is limited! Reserve now! An application form is attached.
