Driving to and from Tabernacle Baptist Academy is a privilege that carries with it a great responsibility. Please read through the following list. These simple guidelines allow us to ensure safety for those driving as well as those walking on campus. Students may not drive and possess a vehicle on campus until they have a valid driver's license. Tabernacle Baptist Academy is a closed campus; students are not permitted to leave the premises until dismissal time without special permission. Being able to drive and possess a vehicle on the premises of Tabernacle Baptist Academy and Tabernacle Baptist Church is a privilege and not a right; the privilege may be revoked at any time. Tabernacle Baptist Academy licensed student drivers must abide by all the following regulations:

- 1. The vehicle must be registered with the Tabernacle Baptist Academy office prior to driving privileges being granted to the student.
- 2. All speed limit signs, directional traffic flow, and other traffic signs must be obeyed.
- 3. The vehicle must be parked in the assigned parking space.
- 4. Students may not go to the vehicle during the school day.
- 5. If a student driver is to transport other students to or from school, or school functions, <u>the parents/legal guardians of the driver and passenger must give written permission for the specific individuals to ride with their son or daughter.</u> This written permission must be on file with the school.
- 6. Students may not have any items in their vehicles that are not allowed at school. This includes, but is not limited to knives, guns, drugs, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, etc.
- 7. Offensive and inappropriate bumper or window stickers are prohibited.
- 8. Music should not be played from a vehicle loud enough to be heard outside the vehicle with the windows down.
- 9. Tabernacle Baptist Academy reserves the right to inspect the vehicle if deemed necessary by the administration.
- 10. Any transfer of the vehicle during the school day (such as the parents picking it up, etc.) must be reported to the academy office.
- 11. No vehicle may carry more riders than there are seat belts.
- 12. All vehicles, drivers, and riders are not only under Tabernacle Baptist Academy guidelines but also under the laws of the State of Virginia when on campus or at Tabernacle Baptist Academy functions.

- 13. If a driver is to check out of school before dismissal time (for example, for a doctor's appointment), a note from the parent/legal guardian must be brought in that morning to the school office, and the parent/guardian may be called by the school for verification.
- 14. When a driver must leave school during the day unexpectedly (for sickness, home emergency, etc.), the parents/legal guardians will be contacted by the school office before the student is allowed to leave the campus.
- 15. Tabernacle Baptist Academy may revoke the driving privilege at any time. After reviewing the circumstances, the privilege may be restored.
- 16. Vehicles should be locked and should not contain any valuables. The school assumes no responsibility for stolen items.
- 17. All drivers and occupants of motor vehicles shall comply with any directions given by authorized school personnel.
- 18. Any vehicle improperly parked may be towed away at the owner's expense.
- 19. Tabernacle Baptist Academy assumes no responsibility for any damage or loss to motor vehicles driven or parked on campus.
- 20. Upon arrival at school, students are required to enter the school building. Students are not allowed to sit in their cars at any time during the school day.
- 21. Students must leave campus after dismissal unless they are participating in after-school activities.
- 22. Tabernacle Baptist Academy reserves the right to change periodically the rules and regulations governing the use of parking facilities. Student drivers will be bound by any such changes.
- 23. Any incident reported and verified involving misconduct or lack of safety at any time may cause a student's driving privilege to be temporarily or permanently suspended or revoked.

Tabernacle Baptist Academy students are expected to represent themselves and the school in a Godly manner 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, 365 days per year. First Offense: Warning. Second Offense: One-week driving suspension. Third Offense: Suspension from driving for one semester or permanently. The administration deems the right to revoke a student's driving privileges any time as they see necessary for the safety of Tabernacle Baptist Academy students, staff, and families.
