Welcome to Hatfield Peverel Village Hall

Welcome to this brochure in which we try and tell you everything that's going on at Hatfield Peverel Village Hall (HPVH). The Hall is an asset for the whole community and the HPVH Committee are keen to ensure it meets the widest needs of the village and is as fully utilised as possible.

Since the last issue, we've refurbished the Vic Olley which can seat up to 50 people and we're hoping to start a film club here soon. We have some fabulous new lighting on our stage (thanks to some generous donations from Hall supporters) and have improved the PA. All the toilets have new loos, hand-dryers, and have been repainted; we have upholstered seating for the hall now and we have a fabulous electronic keyboard that is being used by the Witham Amateur Operatics Society for their rehearsals. Other new groups now running weekly activities in the Hall include "Move it or Lose it", "Weight Watchers" and "Nickelstick Karate". Were also pleased to have Purple Olive Catering using the re-furbished kitchen supporting local schools and councils with affordable meals.

We host or run more than a dozen different clubs and groups that put on weekly activities in the Hall - Kids clubs, Dance, Table Tennis & Badminton, Karate, Dog Training, Social clubs - and more. Every month we also host Events including Bingo, Craft and Farmers Markets, Bands Nights, Comedy Club, Theatre and more. The Village Hall is run by a charitable trust on behalf of the community and we are working hard to improve the Hall's finances which were deteriorating significantly in the previous few years. Important work is required over the coming 5 years to restore and maintain key elements including the roof, the plumbing, access, heating, lighting - the list goes on. We have been successful recently in obtaining some grants to address some basic needs but everything else needs to come from the fees and charges generated from use of the Hall, so we are keen the Hall is used as much as possible.

The Community Cafe

The Community Cafe - in the Lounge is open every weekday from 9am in the morning until 11am and afternoons 2:30-5pm.

Every last Thursday of the month we have Craft Stalls in the Lounge and the "Every Members Club" (EMC) meets every Wednesday from 1pm for Tea, Coffee and refreshments. The EMC club is open to all and everything is included for just £3 per person. It's the best ticket in Hatfield Peverel.




Nickelstick Karate





Not merely a flawless recreation of the incredible music of ELO, this is a spectacular live show from start to finish. Stunning lights and special effects create an atmosphere that will


Theatre: The Nutcracker and the Mouse King
