The purpose of the 2024 Budget Workshop meeting is to discuss the proposed budget.

## Police budget discussions

- Ray Thompson stated that he does not want Township Police working in other iurisdictions.
- The Department spend a lot of time at the Charles and Virginia Hickman Promedica Hospital. Will provide a report of activities.
- Car and body cameras required a tremendous amount of time redacting reports and that is one of the reasons for the additional manpower required in the office.

## Fire discussions

- Chief Bartenslager stated that the Department is down 10 people from the standard manning.
- The wage comparison provided, shows that Adrian Township has the lowest pay of all the surrounding townships.
  - o He recommended a wage proposal which keeps the Township's payroll rates comparable to Raisin Township which is in the middle of the rates.
  - o Ray Thompson felt that a \$16.00 rate for FF/EMT would be reasonable.
  - o Rob Hosken wanted it clarified that the rates proposed would not be subject to the first of the year rate increases given in 2024.

## Supervisor Koehn Comments

- Would consider a ¼ mill increase for Public Safety Millage expiring in 2024.
- The 2024 proposed budget will be presented at the November 13th, Board Meeting.
  - The Second 2024 Budget <u>Public Hearing</u> will be held during the November 13th, 2023, Board Meeting
  - The 2024 Budget will be approved at the December 13th, 2024, Board Meeting
