### NOTES

1. **WELCOME BACK** - First of all, I would like to welcome everyone back from the Summer training period. This year, we will strive to do as much if not more than last year. 2. ANNUAL DUES & FEES – The following Cadets annual dues are up for renewal in November. The renewal fee is \$105.00 check only made out to USNSCC. These dues are to be collected at our November drill weekend.

3. CALLING IN – Cadets must call into DRILL on time or they will not be able to attend. **ANY CADET WHO DOES NOT CALL INTO DRILL WILL BE SENT HOME!** Also, if you report in that you will be attending drill and you fail to show up, you are still responsible to pay the \$45.00 Drill fee. Remind your parents to wait until you are checked in to leave.

4. ANNUAL INSPECTION - Our annual inspection will be conducted at the March drill. Please ensure you have your Service Dress Uniform ready for inspection. After the inspection, we will have a knowledge bowl. **Attendance at Annual Inspection is MANDATORY! Cadets not attending must have a valid excuse. Cadets with unexcused absences may be dismissed from the program.**

5. SEA BAG INSPECTION – Cadets are REQUIRED to bring their entire Sea bag to Drill, where we will conduct inspections moving forward. If you fail to bring required Sea bag items you will be administratively warned.

6. COURSEWORK - All Cadets are required from here forward to turn in at least one (1) coursework assignment per drill. A reminder to those Cadets who have successfully completed Recruit Training: your advancement to E-2 will be delayed until you complete the BMR. Please e-mail the Training Officer if you have any questions.

7. INCREASE YOUR KNOWLEDGE - Find out everything you wanted to know about the U. S. Naval Sea Cadet Corps on the NSCC Online Portal: <http://homeport.seacadets.org/>.

8. ENROLLMENT/DRILL FEES – The cost of Drill is \$45.00 please make check out to (USNSCC) no cash please. The cost of re-enrollment is \$105.00 for both NSCC and NLCC. If you are coming up on your re-enrollment date, please ensure you coordinate with the Admin Officer.

9. CORRESPONDENCE COURSES – Assignments are due each drill. You must complete at least one course per year to remain in the NSCC or the NLCC. See Training Officer for more information.

10. REPORT CARDS – Do not forget to bring in a copy of your report cards for Division Officer Review and possible awards of the Academic Achievement Ribbon. The award of this ribbon has been extended to NLCC Cadet as well.

11. REMIND – Cadets who have not signed up for the Remind App are encouraged to sign up in order to receive updates from the division as emails are sent out. We ask that both the cadet and at least one parent sign up to receive the updates.
