Collaborate with caregivers, schools, and multidisciplinary teams across settings.

IBT Pathway

BY IBAO

- High school diploma or equivalent
- 40 hours of approved IBT training
- 300 hours of supervised practice
- Minimum of 10 hours of supervision
- Two Candidate Skills Tests
- Pass the IBT online examination
- Four CEUs before certification
- Eight CEUs every two years for renewal



ABAT Pathway

BY QABA

- Age 18 or older
- High school diploma or equivalent
- 40 hours of approved training
- Minimum of three hours of Ethics coursework
- Minimum of five hours of Autism core knowledge
- 15 hours of supervised fieldwork at the required ratio
- Supervisor recommendation and required attestations
- Pass the ABAT examination
- Renewal every two years with 12 CEUs, including at least one Ethics hour

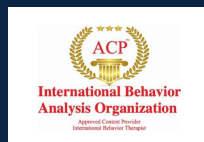
