- Had a one-day (Saturday June 22) NMM Conference with more than 100 people attending- Topics include: Power of Positive Prophecy (Dr. Sonny Kelly); Challenges of church leadership (Rev. Rita Ramphal); Many hands in Church Leadership (Rev. Elena Kelly) and Exegesis, Beatific Leadership, Fiscal responsibility by Dr. Dwarka Ramphal.

- Last year we started one church, then another one last month. In 2024 we returned to the US with seven churches in Africa with more in Uganda and Kenya upcoming. (Potentially 12 by next year).

- Sunday June 23, 2024: Started at 9:00 a.m. with 13 profession of calling and confession of faith- six ministerial ordinations and seven installation of officers at various levels. We welcome Bishop Hamilton and his five churches into the NMM family.

- A Governing board was put in place to help with the reporting- Dr. George, Dr. Oloo, Bishop Hamilton and Bishop Osok.

- We visited a local school and in 2024 helped over 100 students with funds to attend primary and secondary schools (elementary, middle and high school).

- We visited several local entrepreneurs who have benefited from grants donated by New Millennium Ministries and its partners in the US, the Bahamas, and Kenya. We met and encouraged individual pig farmers, vegetable grocers, cooking pot producers, and merchants who were supported by the grants.

- Fayetteville Technical Community College in conjunction with NMM was well recognized when we visited Maseno University and met with the Vice Chancellor (Dr. Julius Nyabundi) to discuss current and future coordination between our two institutions. We received updates from Dr. Caroline Oloo (Business professor) and Dr. George Onyinge (Physics professor) on the six entrepreneurship Global Entrepreneurship award recipients from 2023.

We observed a public health HIV-prevention program that joins the efforts of Duke University researchers, Theater Delta (a Durham-based agency that designs interactive theater for social change), the Tinada youth empowerment group of Kisumu, Kenya, and Kenyan public health professionals.

Dr. Kelly conducted a workshop on performance, public speaking, and audience interaction with over 20 public health, community theater performers, directors, and producers.

In 2024 we support financially 100 students attending elementary, middle and high schools in the Kisumu area.

A FUTURE PLAN FOR OUR CONGREGATION

Keep us in prayer for the vision of the Primary School and Technical School which we hope to have in future to help to improve our community. Keep me in prayer for the ministry am doing here in my community, and the family that I am taking care of.

First and foremost, we have got interested individuals to work with us in the community. eg. Board of Directors, teaching and non-teaching staff. Secondly, we have found land approximately 4 acres located in Akumoi ii village, in Serere district which the owner wants to sale to us at a price of \$2500 per acre which totals to \$10,000 after we shared our vision with him. It is in a good location for the community school, also in this land there are 3 permanent houses which can be renovated and used as class rooms, offices, dormitories so that the work of the will run normally. Not only

that, we have grown beans which the children will eat at school as we hope to start operating it next year.

NMM in Guyana

Guyana- Partnership with several other entities including GB churches, US Churches, FTCC, and individuals. Partnership with Global Revival Ministry to establish a prayer center in Moblisa.

Report from Minister Amola Milo:

In a recent initiative, two barrels of essential supplies were sent to an old age home and an orphanage, successfully impacting the lives of many. They benefitted from hygiene products and towels. The generous effort reached approximately 100 souls- 50 children and adults providing them with much needed support and care. It fostered a sense of solidarity and compassion. In the month of December, I will be continuing this project for 100 individuals.
