



Keystone Apprenticeship Alliance

Overview

The Keystone Apprenticeship Alliance (KAA) is a cross-organizational coalition of practitioners and partners dedicated to promoting and expanding the use of apprenticeship across the state of Pennsylvania.

The Alliance is made up of a diverse range of stakeholders, including labor unions, training providers, employers, community organizations, and government agencies, including the PA Apprenticeship and Training Office (ATO). Through the community of practice model, the KAA provides a platform for members to collaborate, share best practices, and advocate for apprenticeship programs to policy makers, employers, and other community leaders.

KAA Activities include:

- **Monthly Statewide Meetings** with the ATO that include policy & procedure guidance, funding announcements, and other system updates.
- **Monthly Working Group Meetings** focused on specific sectors, including:
 - Agriculture
 - Education
 - Healthcare
 - Manufacturing
 - Public Workforce
 - Technology
- **In-person Meetings** in coordination with PWDA events.
- **Technical Assistance (TA)** for developing and managing RA and Pre-RA programs.
- **Professional Development Activities** to build apprenticeship skills.
- **PA Apprenticeship and Training Council (PATC) Debriefs** following each PATC meeting.

By offering professional development and a community of support to apprenticeship practitioners from a wide range of industries and sectors, the KAA is helping to build the professional field where registered apprenticeship sits – at the intersection of workforce, education, labor, and government.
